### DETAILS:

13 On Thursday, March 8, 2018, I assisted Central Homicide Unit (CHU) Inv. Johnson with an Officer Involved Shooting incident that occurred at 9931 Willowbrook Rd., Jurupa Valley, CA. My assignment was to manage the charting of the Riverside Police Department officers involved with the shooting. This report reflects the charting of RPD Officer Henry Park.

18 The charting of Officer Park took place in the Community Room within the lobby of the Jurupa Valley Sheriff's Station. Present for the charting was Riverside County Sheriff's Forensic Technician Jane Muschell, who photographed process.

22 The charting process started at 11:57PM. Forensic Technician Muschell photographed Officer Park's clothing to memorialize the condition of his uniform at the time of the shooting. He wore (from head to toe) a black t-shirt under a black load bearing (LBV) vest with various pouches sown onto it. The vest had a cloth RPD badge sown on the left chest, a black name tape with H. PARK and a name tape that read POLICE sown onto the right chest. The back of the LBV had a display patch that read POLICE adhered to it. He wore a black nylon uniform belt with a triple magazine pouch, a dump pouch, a handcuff case, and a thigh holster with one leg strap. He wore green BDU pants and black boots. Officer Park also had a Colt M4 Commando rifle slung over his left shoulder at the time of the shooting.

31 At the time of the charting, Officer Park's uniform belt was photographed on a sheet of butcher paper. The belt contained (from right to left) a triple magazine pouch with three steel Mec-Gar 8-round handgun magazines inserted in it. A black nylon dump pouch folded up. A handgun holster with one thigh strap for a Springfield Armory 1911, .45 caliber, semi-automatic pistol (s/n: NM490105), with a mounted Surefire X-300 flashlight (s/n: A52152).

37 The firearm was loaded with one live round in the chamber and loaded with ten live rounds in a 10-round McCormick steel handgun magazine. Each of the three magazines in the magazine pouch contained eight live rounds. Thirty-five rounds were accounted for on the duty belt. Each of the rounds had a head stamp that read WINCHESTER 45 AUTO. Officer Park explained he did not fire his handgun, and he loads his magazines to capacity.

43 Next, Officer Park's LVB was charted. It was removed and placed on a sheet of white butcher paper. The contents of the vest were exposed and recorded. The vest housed a handheld radio, a pry bar, a flashlight, and a digital recorder.

47 Officer Park admitted the Olympus Puma Digital Recorder (Police Special) was activated during the encounter and he felt it recorded the contact and shooting. He permitted me access to the recording and signed a waiver

1 for the recording. I collected the recorder as evidence and allowed Officer Park to review the recording of the  
2 incident prior to his interview with Inv. Johnson.

3  
4 The Colt M4 rifle was also charted. It was placed on a sheet of white butcher paper and photographed. The  
5 Colt M4 Commando rifle (s/n: AO389403) had an Aim-Point Pro optic and a Streamlight TLR-1 flashlight  
6 mounted to it. The rifle was loaded with one round in the chamber and a Magpul magazine, loaded with  
7 twenty-seven rounds in the magazine.

8  
9 The charting process revealed Officer Park carried forty-one rounds on his duty belt. All of Officer Park's  
10 rounds are accounted for.

11  
12 The charting process ended at 12:22AM. Then, Officer Park left the room. A short time later, he met with  
13 Inv. Johnson and an interview was conducted.<sup>1</sup> The charting process continued with the charting of Officer  
14 Sancho Lopez.<sup>2</sup>

15  
16 After Officer Park's interview with Inv. Johnson, I collected the recorder and had the audio track downloaded  
17 later in the day.

18  
19 This is an open investigation and this report's status reflects such. A copy of this report was incorporated into  
20 the investigation file managed by Investigator Johnson.
