DETAILS:

12 On Thursday, March 8, 2018, I assisted Riverside County Sheriff Department Central Homicide Unit (CHU)
13 Investigator Anthony Johnson with an Officer Involved Shooting (OIS) incident at 9931 Willowbrook Road,
14 Jurupa Valley, CA 92509. As part of my responsibilities, I was assigned to author a search warrant for the
15 Willowbrook residence.

17 During the initial stages of the investigation, the residence was secured, and a complete physical description
18 of the residence was obtained. That information was used to create a search warrant tailored to the
19 investigation of an Officer Involved Shooting.

21 The search warrant was presented to Riverside County Superior Court Judge Ronald Taylor on March 9, 2018.
22 Judge Taylor reviewed and approved the search warrant. Once it was approved, a service copy of the search
23 warrant was presented to CHU Inv. Joshua Manjarrez who served the warrant at that location.¹

25 Once the warrant was presented to Inv. Manjarrez, I drove to the Riverside Police Department's Magnolia St.
26 Station to address the audio recording created by Officer Henry Park during OIS.²

28 This is an open investigation and this report's status reflects such. A copy of this report was incorporated into
29 the investigation file managed by Investigator Johnson.







FOR THE FOLLOWING PROPERTY:

1. Dominion & Control

Any items tending to establish the identity of persons who have dominion and control of the location, premises, automobiles, or items to be seized, including delivered mail, whether inside the location or in the mail box/s, bills, utility bills, telephone bills, miscellaneous addressed mail, personal letters, personal identification, purchase receipts, rent receipts, sales receipts, tax statements, payroll check stubs, keys and receipts for safe deposit box(s), keys and receipts for rental storage space, keys and receipts for post office box or mail drop rentals, ignition keys, car door and trunk keys, vehicle ownership certificates or "pink slips," and/or vehicle registration slips, recordation of voice transmissions on telephone answering machines, audio tapes and telephone message receipt books, and written phone messages, and photographs tending to show occupation of the residence / business and connection between co-conspirators, whether identified, or unidentified, also digital pagers which will document telephone numbers of co-conspirators, and if found, to activate the digital pagers' display mechanism and to obtain messages from the pagers, answering machines, tape recorders, and any other recording devices, and to play such devices to obtain their messages. Any examples of handwriting including letters, address books, business records, canceled checks, notes, and/or lists.

2. Videotape, Photograph, Digital Image During Search Warrant Service

Peace Officers or assigned representatives are authorized, during the execution of this Search Warrant, to video tape, photograph and/or take digital images, at the discretion of the Searching Officers, inside and outside of the location, any and all items and/or vehicles at the location, in addition, can identify and photograph and/or digital image all persons present at the Search Warrant location during the period of execution of this Search Warrant.

Any photographs tending to show an association to the victim and / or suspect or other person(s) involved in the crime, be they identified or unidentified.

Any surveillance media, which contains possible footage of the residence before, after, or during the commission of the homicide which would verify what took place, and who was present.

3. Forensic - Photograph, Take Measurements, Seize Weapons & Evidence

Peace Officers or assigned representatives are authorized, during the execution of this Search Warrant, to video tape, photograph, and/or take digital images of the scene and surrounding area(s), take measurements and make sketches of the scene and adjacent areas; and to seize weapons, bludgeons, and guns; suspected blood and other physiological fluids; hair and fibers; fingerprints, footprints, and other impressions left at the **Murder** scene; gunshot residue; any and all instruments used to aid and abet in the commission of the **Murder**, clothing of the suspects(s) and/or victims(s); photos and film, developed and undeveloped; samples of paint, glass, and other fluids and solids that may have stained or adhered to the clothing and person of the victim(s) and/or suspect(s).

4. Biological / Trace Evidence

Including, but not limited to, DNA, hairs, blood, saliva, and/or fingerprints.

Including, but not limited to fibers, hair, soil, wood, gunshot residue and pollen.

5. Clothes / Shoes

Any clothing, shoes, or other items that may appear to have bloodstains.

6. Weapons

Any handgun, pistol, revolver, rifle, shotgun, firearm or automatic weapon. In addition to any firearm, any spent casings, any miscellaneous gun/firearm pieces, ammunition, gun-cleaning items or kits, holsters, ammunition belts, original box packaging materials, clips, magazines, cylinders, or loading devices, targets, expended pieces of lead/bullets, any photographs of firearms, or any paperwork showing the purchase, storage, disposition, and/or dominion and control over any guns, any ammunition, or any of the above items.

7. ALL ELECTRONIC MEDIA (INCLUDING CELL PHONES, COMPUTERS, ETC)

All cell phones, tablets, and/or computer evidence, determined to belong to involved parties of this incident and/or determined to have evidence related to this incident. All data that constitute evidence and instrumentalities of murder, conspiracy to commit murder, weapons possession, prior altercations/threats, and/or domestic violence incidents, which are determined to be relevant to this investigation, between the dates of **December 1, 2017** through **February 1, 2018**.

Cell Phones, Tablets, etc:

- a) All communications content, including email, text (SMS/MMS or app chats), notes, or voicemail. This data will also include attachments, source and destination addresses, and time and date information, and connection logs, images and any other records that constitute evidence and instrumentalities of murder, conspiracy to commit murder, and/or weapons possession for the dates above, including communications referring or relating to this investigation.
- b) All location data for the dates above. Location data may be stored as GPS locations or cellular tower connection data. Location data may be found in the metadata of photos and social networking posts, wi-fi logs, and data associated with installed applications
- c) All photographic/video/audio data and associated metadata
- d) All internet history for the dates above, including cookies, bookmarks, web history, search terms
- e) All financial information.
- f) All indicia of ownership and control for both the data and the cellular device, such as device identification and settings data, address book/contacts, social network posts/updates/tags, wi-fi network tables, associated wireless devices (such as known wi-fi networks and Bluetooth devices), associated connected devices (such as for backup and syncing), stored passwords, user dictionaries.

Computers:

- a) Computer systems found at the location that are capable of recording or storing evidence of the crime being investigated. Computer systems can include desktop personal computer (PCs), laptops, all-in-one computers, tablet-style PCs, servers and handheld computer systems. These systems typically have the

capability for user-interaction and can record user-created files as well as Operating System (OS) artifacts that can show a crime was planned or committed.

- b) Digital storage media found at the location that is capable of storing evidence of the crime being investigated. Digital storage media may be internal to a computer system or external and attached to a computer system. Digital storage media may also be attached wirelessly through a wireless network to a computer system (such as when acting as a 'cloud'). Digital storage media can take the form of hard disk drives, solid state drives, USB thumb drives, tape drives, Iomega ZIP drives, floppy disk drives, and multi-disk Redundant Arrays of Independent Disks (RAID) which combines several storage media devices into a single usable drive.
- c) Random Access Memory or RAM is a volatile section of the computer which stores user and OS information and artifacts while a computer is running. RAM has the ability to store web browsing history, running programs, passwords and user accounts, encryption credentials, and traces of malware while the computer system is running or powered on. Once the system is powered off, this information is lost, hence its volatility. This RAM poses great evidentiary value to a forensic investigator and, if the system is running and accessible, the forensic investigator will need to extract the information from the RAM for later use in his/her investigation.

8. Digital Media and/or storage devices

Any digital media and/or storage devices such as cameras (digital and film), film (developed and undeveloped), camera phones capable of taking pictures, photographic and digital recording devices such as video camcorders, and DVD recorders. Electronic data, including but not limited to, recording devices such as cameras and tape recorders, whether video, audio, digital, or still; computers, day planners, cellular telephones, answering machines, pagers, Personal Digital Assistants (PDA's), Portable Information Management devices (PIM's), palm and pocket PC devices, Global Positioning Satellite devices (GPS), wireless mobile communication devices, and similar handheld devices, which might show the persons associated with and recently communicating with the victim/s and /or suspect/s.

Investigating officers are authorized, at their discretion, to conduct an offsite search of the seized items for the property described. Investigating officers and those agents acting under the direction of the investigating officers are authorized to access all data on the cellular device to determine if the data contains the items as described above. If necessary, investigating officers are authorized to employ the use of outside experts, acting under the direction of the investigating officers, to access and preserve data on the cellular device. Those items that are within the scope of this warrant may be copied and retained by investigative officers.

Utilization of any peace officer or non-peace officer designated by the Riverside County Sheriff's Department who has extensive knowledge of accessing and downloading any of the above listed information.

As required by California Penal Code § 1546.1(d); any information obtained through the execution of this warrant that is unrelated to the objective of the warrant shall be sealed and shall not be subject further review, use, or disclosure absent an order from the Court.

If no evidence of criminal activity is discovered relating to the seized property and associated peripherals, the system will be returned promptly.

9. Gang - General Gang Information

Any written names or monikers on walls, furniture, miscellaneous items or papers, both within and on their residences, and/or within and on their vehicles; any paintings, drawings, film (developed and undeveloped), photographs and/or photograph albums depicting persons, vehicles, weapons, and/or locations;

Any photographs and photograph albums in which are depicted:

- Fellow gang members who are posing and giving gang hand signs, which indicate gang identity or affiliation;
- Gang members or associates posing with weapons, particularly firearms, which are often used for criminal activities;
- Gang members or associates posing beside vehicles, which are occasionally used during the commission of crimes;
- Gang members or associates posing at locations, which are known to be specific gang hangouts; any newspaper clippings tending to relate details or reference to any crime or crimes of violence;

Any scrapbooks of newspaper articles, which describe crimes committed by and/or against their gang; any address books, list of, or single references to, addresses or telephone numbers of persons who may later be determined to belong to or be affiliated with any street gang/s;

Any current phone numbers, addresses of fellow gang members with whom they associate;

Any letters and/or documents, whether in actual written form or stored in an electronic (computerized) manner, which would appear to make reference to membership and/or activities of any criminal street gang;

Any information about gang membership, gang rosters, members and/or graffiti regarding the writer's gang;

Any audiocassettes with gang graffiti and sometimes monikers on them, video tapes which depict gang activity such as gang members posing with and firing weapons, gang parties where gang members pose with weapons and flash gang signs with their hands, and make statements about their gang;

10. Additional Evidence

Any other evidence not yet identified, which tends to establish that the crime of attempted murder or assault with a deadly weapon has been committed and that (Ernie Saldivar) and/or any other persons not yet identified has committed such crime. Writings, journals, diaries, logs, documentation or evidence tending to show the nature, intent, or motive of the crime being investigated, including but not limited to, divorce or separation documents, documents describing prior acts of domestic violence, documents showing hostility toward the victim or suspect, documents tending to show financial gain, such as insurance policies and assets held by the victim/s and / or suspect/s.
