1 **PROPERTY / SCENE DESCRIPTION:**

2 The residence located at 9931 Willowbrook Rd., in the city of Jurupa Valley, County of Riverside,
3 State of California, is further described as a single-story residence located on the north side of
4 Willowbrook Rd. The residence had tan stucco with brown trim. The residence had two garages
5 on the west side of the residence. Garage 1 door faced south with an interior entry/exit door located
6 inside the garage and on the southeast side that provided access into the kitchen of the residence.
7 Garage 2 was located east of Garage 1 with the door facing west. Garage 2 had an entry/exit door
8 located on the northeast side that provided access into the laundry room of the residence. The
9 residence had a driveway located on the west side of the residence that leads from the asphalt
10 street of Willowbrook Rd., and to the garages of the residence.

11
12 The residence had a concrete walkway leading from the driveway and to the double front doors
13 that faces south. The residence had a front lawn located on the east of the driveway and south of
14 front door. The residence has a wooden perimeter rear fence and a shed on the northeast side of
15 the backyard. Upon entering the front door there is a walkway with a formal room to the east. North
16 of the formal room was a hallway that traveled east and west. East of the hallway and formal room
17 were four bedrooms and two bathrooms. The master bedroom (Bedroom 1) was located north of
18 the hallway and on the northeast side of the residence. The door to Bedroom 1 faced south. The
19 master bedroom had a large restroom (Restroom 1) with a walk-in closet on the south side of the
20 restroom.

21
22 The residence had a bedroom (Bedroom 2) located south of Bedroom 1 and on the east side of
23 the residence. The door of Bedroom 2 faced east. Located south of Bedroom 2 was a bathroom
24 (Bathroom 2) with the door facing west and a bedroom (Bedroom 3) located southwest of
25 Bathroom 2. The door of Bedroom 3 faced north. Located east of Bedroom 3 was a bedroom
26 (Bedroom 4) with the door facing west.

27
28 Located west of the hallway upon entering the front door was a dining room with a large wooden
29 dining room table in the center of the room and a China cabinet against the west dining room wall,
30 located west of the dining room table. The dining room had an entry/exit pathway with not door
31 that lead to a room that contained cabinets and the location where Saldivar's body rested.

32
33 Located north of the dining room was the living room with a chimney on the east side of the room.
34 Located on the northwest side of the living room was a glass door slider leading to the back yard.
35 The affixed glass slider located on the west side was shattered and the retractable slider door that
36 contained the locking latch was not shattered or damaged. Located west of the living room and
37 rear glass sliding door was the kitchen. Located south of the kitchen was a small room containing
cabinets and a granite countertop cabinet on the east side of the wall. In this room Saldivar's body
rested with his feet to the south and his head to the north. Saldivar's body was faced up.

1 Located west of Saldivar's body was a restroom (Restroom 3) with the door facing east. Located
2 south of the restroom was a bedroom (Bedroom 5) with the door facing east. South of the room
3 where Saldivar's body rested was a door that opened inward which lead to the laundry room. The
4 laundry room was in between Garage 2 and the room where Saldivar's body rested. The entry/door
5 leading from the garage and into the laundry room opened inward and into the laundry room. The
6 door had what appeared to a strike mark (Photographic point A). On the evening of this
7 investigation, the weather was fair with an abundance of function lights from the street lights and
8 interior of the residence, allowing for a good visibility.

13 DETAILS:

14 On Thursday, March 8, 2018, about 1800 hours, Sergeant Ramirez of the Riverside County
15 Sheriff's Department Central Homicide Unit (CHU) contacted me to assist Investigator Johnson,
16 Investigator Gomez and Investigator Barajas with an officer involved shooting investigation that
17 occurred in the city of Jurupa Valley. Responding from the city of Perris, I arrived at the scene
18 located at 9931 Willowbrook Rd., in the city of Jurupa Valley, at 2002 hours.

19
20 Sergeant Ramirez provided me with the known facts of this case and informed me that Investigator
21 Johnson was assigned as primary, Investigator Gomez was assigned as secondary, Investigator
22 Barajas was assigned to assist with the authoring of search warrants and I was assigned to
23 process the scene.
24

25 Jurupa Valley Station Sergeant Ricken conducted the initial briefing (Refer to supplement reports).
26 Upon the completion of the briefing, I joined Sergeant Ramirez, Investigator Johnson, Investigator
27 Barajas, Deputy District Attorney Cook, Deputy Coroner Gonzalez, Forensic Technicians Scott
28 and Whaley with an initial walkthrough of the scene at 2040 hours.

30 The above listed personnel entered the residence through the front door where Deputy Balderama,
31 who was inside the residence escorted us into the residence. Upon entering the residence, I
32 noticed a hole in the dining room drywall located west of the front door. We continued to walk
33 through the living room where I noticed the rear sliding glass door was shattered. While in the
34 living room and from a distance the body of Ernie Saldivar was in plain view with in a room
35 containing cabinets just southeast of the kitchen. Saldivar's body was facing upward with his feet
36 to the south and head to the north. Saldivar's body had what appeared to be medical intervention
37 equipment attached to his body. I escorted the above listed personnel through the front door and
38 to the command post at 2053 hours.

1 I gathered Riverside Police Department personnel, Lieutenant Dailey, Sergeant Weier, Sergeant
2 Outlaw and Riverside City Attorney Okazaki outside of the perimeter. I escorted Riverside Police
3 Department personnel into the residence through the front door and conducted a walkthrough of
4 the scene without disturbing any items of evidence or entering past the living area at 2103 hours.
5 Upon the completion of the walkthrough, I escorted Riverside Police Department to the command
6 post at 2117 hours. Investigator Liu assigned to the Jurupa Valley Station was in the process of
7 authoring the search warrant for the residence.

8
9 Forensic Technician Scott and I proceeded to process the outside scene by taking exterior
10 photographs of the residence and Riverside Police Department vehicle parked on Willowbrook
11 Rd., Jurupa Valley, just south of the residence. Upon taking photographs of the scene from the
12 street, Forensic Technician Scott and I proceeded to process the Riverside Police Department
13 vehicles parked on Willowbrook Rd., Jurupa Valley by taking photographs and documenting the
14 firearms located inside the vehicles (Refer to the above noted Riverside Police Vehicle heading
15 for further detail).

16
17 Investigator Liu authored the search warrant for the residence which was approved and signed by
18 the Honorable Judge Trask, Riverside Superior Courts (Warrant #RI040520189). The search
19 warrant was approved for the garage and laundry room leading to the Saldivar's body. I obtained
20 a service copy and with the assistance of Forensic Technicians Scott and Whaley began to
21 process the garage, laundry room leading to Saldivar's body.

22
23 Forensic Technician Scott took overall photographs of the residence to include the interior of
24 garage, laundry room and Saldivar's body in its original state. Upon the completion of taking
25 photographs, I began to search and process the garage located south of the laundry room where
26 I located and Forensic Technician Scott collected items JM01-JM16 (Refer to the above listed
27 evidence description for further detail). Upon completing the garage, Forensic Technician Scott
28 and I proceeded to the laundry room located north of the garage. I noticed the man door leading
29 from the garage and to the laundry room had a strike mark (Refer to photographic point A).

30
31 Upon entering the laundry room Forensic Technician Scott and I located and collected items JM17-
32 JM25 (Refer to the above listed evidence description for further detail). I noticed a strike mark on
33 the top lifted metallic lid of the washing machine. The washing machine was located on the east
34 wall of the laundry room. The strike mark appeared to go through the metallic lid and through the
35 east drywall leading into the dining room located east of the laundry room. (Refer to photographic
36 point B). Located on the northeast laundry room wall underneath the soap dispenser was an
37 additional strike mark that did not appear to go through any other wall (Refer to photographic point
38 C). Upon completion of the Laundry room, Forensic Technician Scott and I proceeded to the room
39 located north of the laundry room where the body of Saldivar rested.

1 I noticed Saldivar lying on the tile floor facing upward with his feet to the south and head to the
2 north. Saldivar's hands were behind his back and his shirt appeared to be cut, exposing his chest.
3 Saldivar had medical intervention equipment on his chest and mouth. Saldivar face, arms and
4 torso were covered in blood and the tile where he rested had what appeared to be blood stains.
5 Located on top of a granite counter top, east of Saldivar was a black semi-automatic firearm with
6 a loaded magazine and live round adjacent to the firearm (Items JM31-JM31-B). In this room
7 Forensic Technician Scott and I located and collected items JM26-JM31E. Upon completion of this
8 room, Coroner Sergeant Albert and Deputy Coroner Gonzalez entered the residence and began
9 to analyze Saldivar's body (Refer to Deputy Coroner Gonzalez' report for further detail).

10
11 Deputy Coroner Gonzalez positioned Saldivar on his stomach by rotating his body to the east
12 where I noticed Saldivar's hands were handcuffed behind his back. Saldivar had numerous tattoos
13 on his forearms and "ESR" tattooed on his back. Saldivar back appeared to be covered in blood.
14 Deputy Coroner Gonzalez collected and packaged items JM34-JM35 and gave them to me for
15 evidence. Deputy Coroner Gonzalez placed toe tag #53630 on Saldivar's right toe and with the
16 assistance of Coroner Sergeant Albert and her transport personnel, placed Saldivar in a body bag
17 and gurney. The body bag containing Saldivar inside was closed and sealed (#093509) at 0450
18 hours. Saldivar's body was removed to the scene and transported to the Riverside County Sheriff's
Department Coroner's Office.

21 About 0600 hours, Forensic Technician Scott and Whaley gave me the collected, packaged and
22 sealed evidence items and departed from the scene. Jurupa Valley Station Deputy Martinez
23 arrived and remained in the garage pending an additional warrant authored by Investigator Barajas
24 and the arrival of Forensic Technician Leon to complete the processing of the scene.

25
26 On March 9, 2018, Investigator Barajas authored the search warrant for the residence, which was
27 approved by the Honorable Judge Taylor, Riverside Superior Courts (Warrant #RI030920183).
28 The search warrant was approved for the entire residence, to include garages, grounds,
29 outbuildings, locked containers, safes to include all vehicles on the property. Jurupa Valley Station
30 Personnel, Sergeant Torrenti, Investigator Peters, Investigator Perez and Investigator Martinez
31 arrived to the scene to assist with searching for items of evidential value.

33 At 0950 hours, Forensic Tech Leon arrived and began to take overall photographs of the
34 residence. During the process of taking interior photographs of the residence, I searched the area
35 where the north sliding glass door was shattered for projectiles, but I did not locate any (Refer to
36 photographic point D).

38 Upon the completion of taking overall photographs of the residence, I searched the dining room
39 area and located a strike mark on the west wall (Photographic point C) that appeared to strike the
40 China cabinet that rested against the west wall. I continued to search the room and located item

6 items of evidential value. The processing of the scene was completed about 1230 hours. Prior to
7 departing from the residence, I left the search warrant service copies and property receipt form on
8 top of the kitchen table. I secured and exited the residence at 1251 hours. I then relocated to the
9 Jurupa Valley Station and entered the items into evidence under this file number.
10

11 On Monday, March 12, 2018, Investigator Gomez requested I retrieved evidence item JM04 (Keys)
12 and release them to the owner, Stephanie Lucio. At 0927 hours, I contacted Lucio at the Jurupa
13 Valley Station front lobby and gave her item JM04. Lucio collected the item and signed the
14 Riverside County Sheriff's Department property release receipt.

16 This investigation will be forwarded to Investigator Johnson for final disposition.
