Investigator Peters requested video for March 8, 2018, from 1715 hours to 1800 hours from Camera 2 and 9.

DETAILS:

On March 8, 2018, I responded to the area of Willowbrook Road and met with Investigator Peters. We contacted the homeowner, Mr. [REDACTED] who gave written consent for me to download and save video files from the Nightowl Digital Video Recorder (DVR). The residence was equipped with one standalone DVR system which was located in an office closet at the back of the residence. I checked the system's date and time. The DVR's system date and time was March 8, 2018 at 2210 hours which was 18 minutes fast according to my T-Mobile cellular device which read March 8, 2018, at 2152 hours.



The system had the capabilities to record sixteen (16) cameras; however, only fourteen (14) were installed and recording. The video system was set to record continuously. I collected video from camera 2 and 9 for March 8, 2018, from 1715 hours, to 1800 hours (DVR Time).

Mr. [REDACTED] assisted me with placing my USB flash drive into the USB port on the front of the DVR, as a ladder was required to reach the system inside the closet. Once he placed my USB flash drive into the USB port on the front of the DVR, I exported all requested video from the DVR system for the above listed date/times. The system created video files with a 264 File extension; however, a proprietary player was not exported which was required to view the video files.
