6 **Narrative:**

7 On 10/31/16 at approximately 0001 hours, partner Officer Brandt and I were flagged down by a subject on
8 the corner of St. Lawrence Street and Mar Vista Ct. in the city and county of Riverside reference a possible
9 theft of wooden pallets from a business on Mar Vista Ct. See Officer Brandt's initial report for further details.

10
11 We drove west on Mar Vista Ct. and saw an older model white Chevy pick-up truck backed up to the outside
12 west side of the west wall of 8138 Mar Vista Ct. We got out of the police car to investigate why the truck was
13 parked there with a large stack of wooden pallets in the bed. As I approached the vehicle from the passenger
14 side, I saw feet on the driver side of the vehicle under the truck. I drew my firearm and called out to the
15 subject to come out where I could see him with his hands in the air. As I rounded the front of the vehicle I
16 saw a subject, later identified as S/Hayes, running to where the chain link fence and block wall meet at the
17 south west corner of the parking lot. See above map for aerial view.

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1 S/Hayes was a white male wearing a black shirt, jeans and black gloves. S/Hayes looked like he was
2 approximately 50 years old. As S/Hayes jumped the fence, Officer Brandt went to the north east wall of the
3 property to try and locate S/Hayes in the rear yard of the business. I got on top of the wall at the north-west
4 corner of the property to keep a visual. When I got on top of the wall, I did not see anyone and took a
5 position at the bottom of the wall near where the truck was parked. S/Hayes then looked back over the wall
6 at the truck as if he was going to try to jump back over to my side. I called out to S/Hayes telling him to put
7 his hands in the air and jump over the wall slowly. He said "ok ok" and then jumped down off of what he was
8 standing on. He was still on the east side of the wall at this time. Being on the west side of the wall I did not
9 see S/Hayes again after he jumped down.

10 Over the radio, Officer Brandt said he saw the subject running toward St. Lawrence Street. See his initial
11 report for details.

12 Investigation:

13 Due to the business being closed at the time, I had dispatch attempt to locate a responsible party for the
14 business at 8138 Mar Vista Ct. to verify no one had permission to take the pallets from the property.
15 O/Piantadosi responded and told me no one had permission to be on the property or to take the pallets.

16 I opened the driver side door of S/Hayes' vehicle to see if I could locate any identification for the driver.
17 Officer Avila opened the passenger side door and found a brown leather wallet on the seat. The ID inside the
18 wallet did not belong to S/Hayes.

19 O/Piantadosi recognized the truck as one that was at the business earlier in the week to pick up the broken
20 pallets and take them away. The subject that was at the business earlier was a white male in his 50's and had
21 another person in his 20's with him at the time. I asked O/Piantadosi if he knew the name of the subjects that
22 the truck belonged to but he did not know. O/Piantadosi said the person that was in the truck did not have
23 permission to take anything from or be on the property at this time. O/Piantadosi unlocked and opened the
24 gate on the north-west side of the property so we could safely clear the lot.

25 As soon as O/Piantadosi opened the gate he told the pallets that were stacked against the wall should not be
26 there. He said it looked like someone took them down off of the shelves where they usually are to the east.
27 See above photo for further on their location. He said the business had approximately 100 pallets stolen from
28 the property last month and they submitted surveillance video from the adjacent building at 8178 Mar Vista
29 that showed the previous theft. O/Piantadosi does desire prosecution for the theft on behalf of the business.

30 I was unable to contact anyone at California Interfill, 8178 Mar Vista Ct., to get the footage of tonight's
31 incident because they were closed at the time.


