**Narrative:**

On 11-1-08 I was at the Magnolia Police Station assisting with an Officer Involved Fatal Incident. I was asked to assist with photographing and collecting the uniforms of Officers Daniel Koehler and Jeffrey Ratkovich after their interviews.

I escorted Officer Koehler to the ID Tech photography room where ID Tech McKay-Davis took overall and close up photographs of Officer Koehler's face, uniform and duty belt. Officer Koehler had abrasions on his upper lip, above his right eye and to the back of his neck. Officer Koehler had redness and abrasions on both knees and complained of pain to his right shoulder (No visible injury to this area). Officer Koehler was also walking with a noticeable limp. ID Tech McKay Davis photographed all these injuries.

I escorted Officer Koehler to the men's locker room where he changed out of his duty uniform into civilian clothes. I collected Officer Koehler's duty uniform including his badge and name tag per Sgt. Rossi. The uniform with the badge and name tag attached were packaged in brown paper bags and given to ID Tech McKay-Davis for collection.

I listened to Officer Koehler's digital recorder that was located on his duty belt. Officer Koehler had two recordings, but neither one involved this incident. I returned Officer Koehler's recorder and advised him to download those recording as he normally would.

I then escorted Officer Ratkovich to the ID Tech photography room after his interview where ID Tech McKay-Davis took overall and close up photographs of Officer Ratkovich's face, uniform and duty belt. Officer Ratkovich did not have any visible injuries and did not complain of pain.

I escorted Officer Ratkovich to the men's locker room where he changed out of his duty uniform into civilian clothes. I collected Officer Ratkovich's duty uniform per Sgt. Rossi. The uniform was packaged in brown paper bags and given to ID Tech McKay-Davis for collection. I also collected Officer Ratkovich's taser from his duty belt. The taser was packaged in a brown paper bag and given to Sgt. Rossi.

Officer Ratkovich did not have any recordings on his issued digital recorder. Officer Ratkovich's recorder was in the trunk of his police unit, because he was carrying a COBAN recorder on his duty belt.
