At the same time, a separate Metro surveillance team was conducting a surveillance of 7680 Gramercy Pl. where the suspect's mother had been followed by surveillance units in an attempt to locate S1. At approx. 1445 hours, the surveillance team at the Gramercy Pl. address observed a subject matching the description of S1 walk out of the residence, get on a bicycle and ride away. Moments later, a the surveillance team put out that shots were fired and the suspect was down. Narrative:

Upon arrival, a crime scene was being set up. I contacted Lt. Phillips, who was on scene, and offered my assistance. Canvassing was already done, so I stood by as peer support with Officer Dawson Smith, who was a witness to the incident, and waited to transport him after he briefed the responding OIS Team. In addition, myself and Officer Smith assisted evidence technician Tim Ellis set up barrier screens around S1's final position on the sidewalk.

After Officer Smith briefed the OIS Team, I transported him to Magnolia Station for interview. When this was done, I drove back to the scene to help transport the involved Metro vehicles out of the crime scene and back to Aviation. As soon as the vehicles were cleared, I was instructed I was no longer needed and ended my shift.
