On 2/18/12, I witnessed the charting and photographs of Sgt. McCoy's weapon used in this shooting. The charting and photographs took place in the Evidence Technician's office at the Magnolia Station. Evidence Technician Sue Lane took the photographs and charted the weapon.

Sgt. McCoy and his attorney, Russell Perry, were present during the charting and photographs.

Sgt. McCoy's weapon and ammunition are listed as follows:

Weapon used

- Springfield Operator-45, 45 automatic handgun.
- Serial number [REDACTED]
- Handgun contained one 45 automatic magazine with (6) Winchester 45 Auto bullets.
- Handgun contained (1) Winchester 45 Auto bullet in the chamber.

It should be noted that Sgt. McCoy stated he reloaded his handgun during the initial shooting with a full magazine.

Extra magazines

Sgt. McCoy had (3) extra magazines in his magazine pouch which was attached to his duty belt. Each magazine contained (7) Winchester 45 Auto bullets.

Sgt. McCoy did not carry a back-up weapon.

Photographs and charting

Prior to the charting and photographs of his handgun, I witnessed Sgt. McCoy draw his handgun from his holster and remove the magazine. I then witnessed him remove (1) live round from the chamber.

Evidence Technician Lane and I counted the bullets from the handgun and extra magazines. She then took photographs of them.

Sgt. McCoy kept the original (3) extra magazines and bullets. He also removed and kept the flashlight attached to his handgun.

The handgun, along with the magazine and bullets removed from the handgun, were collected as evidence by Evidence Technician Lane.
