Initial response

On 2/18/12, at approximately 1500 hours, I received a phone call at home regarding an Officer Involved Shooting which occurred in front of 5652 Harold Street. I responded to the scene and assisted with interviews.

Interview of Eliseo Salgado (Witness)

I spoke to W-Salgado in the garage of 5664 Harold Street. He said he saw the police officers shoot the man who was dead on the sidewalk. He spoke Spanish, so Officer Angulo translated the interview. The interview was digitally recorded and later downloaded to the department server.

W-Salgado said he was sitting in a plastic chair which was at the garage door, on the south side of the garage. The garage door was open.

W-Salgado said that he saw a black and white police car drive up to the driveway where he was, and park at an angle. He saw two police officers in uniform get out of the car and look south down the sidewalk. He then saw a male (S-Bond) on a bike, where the officers were looking. He said S-Bond dropped the bike and started running south, away from the officers. He heard the officers yell at S-Bond to stop, three times.

W-Salgado said that when S-Bond started running, a [REDACTED] parked, and a cop got out of it. He said S-Bond saw the cop and turned back towards the two uniformed officers. He said S-Bond stopped and lifted up the front of his shirt with his left hand and reached for his front waistband with his right hand. He said he saw S-Bond pull something out of his waistband. He said he did not see what it was, but he believed he was pulling out a gun. He said the two officers then shot S-Bond. He said the cops fired 8 or 9 times.

W-Salgado pointed to where the cops were when they shot at S-Bond. He described them as being half way between the rear of the police car to where S-Bond was laying on the ground.

W-Salgado said, "The officers fired in self-defense". He said the officers gave S-Bond a chance. He said S-Bond didn't want to listen to the officers so they had to defend themselves. He said S-Bond could have shot anybody. He never heard S-Bond say anything.

I looked at the chair where W-Salgado was sitting when he witnessed the shooting. A small tree was in his line of site to S-Bond, but S-Bond was still visible through the small tree. He could easily have seen S-Bond's actions.

W-Salgado had no further information.
