**Interview of Lorie Rivera**

During the course of this investigation, I learned that S-Bond's mother, O-Rivera lived at 7680 Gramercy Place. I learned that she had heard that the deceased male in this case may be her son. I went to the address to speak to her. Sgt. Dinco and two patrol officers were present during the interview. The interview was digitally recorded and later downloaded to the department server.

When I contacted O-Rivera, I told her that her son was shot and killed. She was upset, but said I could talk to her.

O-Rivera said that S-Bond was in the house with her before he was shot. She said she knew that the police were looking for S-Bond, but she did not know why. She said everything was fine with S-Bond before he left. She said he was going to the store to get some cigarettes. She said he left on his bike. She said that after he left, she heard gunshots down the street.

O-Rivera kept talking about the problems S-Bond was having with his girlfriend. She would continue talking about them, and I had to interrupt her to ask about her son's actions prior to him leaving the house.

I asked O-Rivera if she ever saw S-Bond with a gun. She said no. She said he has never had a gun. She said she does not have any guns in her house.

O-Rivera was beginning to get mad at us, for shooting her son. I then told her that her son had a gun with him when he was killed. She then said that police should not have shot him so many times. At that point I decided to end the interview because no productive information was being obtained.
