Narrative:

On 2-22-12 I responded to the Riverside Coroner's Office for the autopsy of S/ Danny Bond. The autopsy began at 0900 hours and was performed by Dr. Fajardo. RPD Evidence Tech Selena McKay-Davis and Forensic Tech Frisby took overall photos of S/ Bond and his injuries. Dr. Fajardo removed both brown paper bags from S/ Bond's hands. Id Tech McKay-Davis collected the brown paper bags and S/ Bond's clothing. Dr. Fajardo took fingernail clippings from both hands. S/ Bond was wearing a red t-shirt, white tank top, blue jeans, black belt, blue/ white long underwear and a gold ring on his right pinky finger. Dr. Fajardo located several pieces of hard plastic on S/ Bond's shirt and under it. It was unknown what those plastic pieces were from. I advised Dr. Fajardo that S/ Bond was wearing a jacket during the shooting and he said the pieces were possibly from the jacket. S/ Bond had dragon type tattoos on his right bicep, left bicep and back. He had an "I" on his right chest, an "E" on his left chest and lips with the name "Nicholes" on his left shoulder.

Dr. Fajardo completed an overall exterior examination of S/ Bond. Dr. Fajardo noted (10) ten gunshot wounds. Dr. Fajardo said there were (7) seven entry wounds, (1) one exit wound and two graze wounds. Dr. Fajardo noted a graze wound to S/ Bond's left thigh and his left side. S/ Bond had a gunshot entry wound on the left side of his chest just left of his left nipple. S/ Bond had a gunshot entry wound on his left side towards his back. Dr. Fajardo noted (4) four more gunshot entry wounds in the center of S/ Bond's back just left of his spine. S/ Bond also had a gunshot entry wound to his left buttock. Dr. Fajardo noted a gunshot exit wound to S/ Bond's upper right chest. Dr. Fajardo also noted an abrasion to S/ Bond's right knee. Dr. Fajardo said S/ Bond had a wound (exit) in the center of his chest (sternum area) where a projectile came to rest just under S/ Bond's skin. There was also a wound just below S/ Bond's belly button that Dr. Fajardo said was possible caused by a fragment. Dr. Fajardo used probes to show the angles the bullets entered S/ Bond's body. The probes showed the wounds in the back area were from left to right and upward. See McKay-Davis' photos.

Dr. Fajardo recovered (6) six projectiles inside of S/ Bond's body. A projectile was recovered under the skin in the front of the chest (sternum); (1) one was recovered from his right upper bicep; (2) two were recovered in his right rear shoulder; (1) one was recovered from the left mastoid (under left ear near base of skull); And (1) one was recovered in his the middle of his back on the right side. The projectiles were collected and booked into property by ID Tech McKay-Davis.

Dr. Fajardo then conducted an internal examination of S/ Bond's internal organs. Dr. Fajardo stated S/ Bond had several internal injuries caused by the gunshot wounds. Dr. Fajardo said S/ Bond had a gunshot wounds to his left kidney, both lungs and (2) two or (3) three shots hit his heart. Dr. Fajardo said S/ Bond had no injuries to his head/ brain.
