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Scene Description:

The parking lot stall (#111) where V-1 vehicle was taken was located on the south / east side of the complex.

On Tuesday 02/26/13 at approximately 0900 Hrs. I was dispatched to the Pepper Tree's apartment complex, located at 7911 Arlington Ave. reference a call of a vehicle theft. The call text indicated that the reporting party, later found to be RP-1 / RO Maria Rico was calling from apartment #332 to report her Honda Civic was stolen. The call text also indicated the vehicle had been stored for evidentiary purposes by the Riverside Police Dept. due to it being involved in a major incident last night (02/25/13). Refer to initial and supplemental reports for further on the incident.

Narrative:

When I arrived, I contacted Rico outside her apartment. She then followed me to my vehicle where I obtained a recorded statement from her. The following is a summary of her recorded statement.

Rico stated on Monday 02/25/13 at approximately 1900 Hrs. she arrived home from Riverside Community College and parked her vehicle near her apartment. Rico stated when she parked the vehicle all doors were locked and secure. Rico then went into her apartment and went to bed. At approximately 0800 Hrs. Rico stated she woke up to go to work. When she made it outside to leave, she noticed her vehicle was gone. Rico said she talked to her mother, who informed her when she arrived home (Rico's mother) at 2000 Hrs. she noticed that her (Rico's) vehicle was still parked in its stall. Rico said she called the police to inform them of the theft, but was told her vehicle was being held as evidence by the department.

Rico stated that no one had permission to take her vehicle. I clarified that statement, by asking her if that included family members, to which she replied that no one should have her vehicle.

Rico had no further specific details regarding this incident.

Once finished talking to Rico, I had her escort me to where she parked her vehicle. She was then escorted through the complex until we arrived at stall #111, where she told me that's where she parked her vehicle.

Once I located the area where the vehicle was taken from, I provided Rico with a copy the report number and my contact information and cleared the scene.

When I cleared the scene, I contacted Riverside Dispatcher #1729 who removed Rico's vehicle as stored for evidence. He then entered and removed Rico's vehicle from SVS and then reentered it as stored for evidence.
