On 3/1/12, at approximately 0300 hours, I received a phone call at home regarding an Officer Involved Shooting. Upon arrival, I was assigned to investigate the crime scene.

During the preliminary briefing, information was given to me, stating that Officer Lopez and his partner, Officer Porter were conducting a traffic stop of a Ford van on Anna Street. The passenger, S-Dunbar, ran from the van and Officer Lopez gave chase. S-Dunbar ran south on Anna Street and jumped over a block wall leading to the backyard at 2914 Hyde Park Circle. S-Dunbar had a handgun and was shot by Officer Lopez.

Preliminary walk-thru of crime scene

The following personnel, along with myself, were assigned to inspect the crime scene prior to the investigation:

During the early stages of the investigation, Lieutenant V. Williams entered the crime scene at the Lincoln Street and Anna Street perimeter. He walked a short distance then left the scene. He was not near any physical evidence.

Detective Brandt, Evidence Technician Fuller and I investigated the scene.

Video and photographs

Evidence Technician Fuller videotaped and photographed the entire crime scene.

Crime scene - Traffic stop

The suspect van was a 2002 Ford Windstar van, white in color. California license [REDACTED]

The suspect van was parked on Anna Street in front of 2966. The van was facing North, in the middle of the street. The officer's police unit (#3908) was parked behind the van also facing north. The center of the police unit was aligned to the left side of the suspect van.

Both front doors of the suspect van were open.

Both spotlights of the police unit were on and pointing at the suspect van. The police unit's front red emergency light was also on.

Information from the preliminary briefing, stated that S-Dunbar ran from the suspect van heading South on Anna Street.

There was a planter area with some bushes on the Anna Street side of the wall leading to 2914 Hyde Park Circle.

The following evidence items were found on Anna Street, in the grass area, and in the planter described in the previous paragraph:

1. (1) Casing. Winchester 40 S&W. Found in grass near wall leading to 2914 Hyde Park Circle.
2. (1) Casing. Winchester 40 S&W. Found in planter near wall leading to 2914 Hyde Park Circle.
3. (1) Casing. Winchester 40 S&W. Found in planter near wall leading to 2914 Hyde Park Circle.
4. (1) Casing. Winchester 40 S&W. Found in bush near wall leading to 2914 Hyde Park Circle.
5. (1) Police radio. Found in a bush near wall leading to 2914 Hyde Park Circle.
6. (1) Flashlight (On). Found in grass near wall leading to 2914 Hyde Park Circle.
7. (1) Nike white tennis shoe (Left). Found in grass between suspect van and wall leading to 2914 Hyde Park Circle.
8. (1) Nike white tennis shoe (Right). Found in grass between suspect van and wall leading to 2914 Hyde Park Circle.
9. (1) Sanyo cell phone. Found on the street just outside the front passenger door of the suspect van.
10. (1) Boost Mobile cell phone. Found on the front driver seat of the suspect van.
11. (1) Casing. Winchester 40 S&W. Found in planter near wall leading to 2914 Hyde Park Circle.

Crime scene – Backyard of 2914 Hyde Park Circle

The backyard has a small cement patio area, and a small grass area. There is a small planter between the grass and the East wall. There is another planter with large bushes along the South wall of the next door neighbor.

The suspects clothing, along with a large amount of blood was found on the grass, at the base of the planter separating the grass from the East wall.

A Taurus 9mm handgun was found in the planter separating the grass from the East wall, right at the base of the wall. The gun had dirt and mud on it. There was one live round in the chamber and 15 live rounds in the magazine. One of the live rounds was stuck in the magazine.

Four projectiles were found in the grass near the suspects clothing, and in the planter near the South/east corner of the yard.

A metal wind chime was hanging from the patio, between the West wall and the suspects clothing. There appeared to be a bullet hole in the wind chime. A piece of the wind chime was on the ground, between the hanging wind chime and the suspects clothing.

Evidence items found in backyard of 2914 Hyde Park Circle:

12. Taurus 9mm handgun. Serial [REDACTED] (1) Live round in chamber. (15) Live rounds in magazine.
13. Bloody clothing belonging to suspect, including (2) shirts, (1) black hooded sweatshirt with blue "Cowboys" gloves in left pocket. Found on grass near East planter.
14. (1) Pair of jeans with blood on them. Found on grass near East planter.
- 14a. Kansas driver's license in name of Brandon Dunbar. Found in wallet in Item 14.
15. (1) Projectile. Found in grass area near suspect clothing.
16. Piece of broken wind chime. Found on cement patio.
17. Wind chimes. Found hanging from cover above patio.
18. (1) Projectile. Found in planter near South/east corner of yard.
19. (1) Projectile. Found in planter near South/east corner of yard.
20. (1) Projectile. Found in grass near suspect clothing.

Evidence collection and scene measurements

Detective Brandt and I assisted Evidence Technician Fuller with measurements of the crime scene area and evidence.

Evidence Technician McKay-Davis arrived during the scene investigation to assist.

Evidence Technician Fuller collected all evidence.

Crime scene clean-up

Due to the large amount of blood in the grass in the backyard of 2914 Hyde Park Circle, members of the Technical Services Unit arrived to clean and remove the blood.
