Narrative of Supplemental Report:

On 03/26/2012, evidence item CF-12 was released to me at 1445 hours for processing. I placed that item into my locked evidence cabinet. Detective Medici requested that I conduct a latent print search on the above item.

On 04/17/2012, at 1500 hours, I retrieved item CF-12 from my lab cabinet and observed dirt and debris all over the weapon. I then conducted a search for latent prints using Bi-chromatic fingerprint powder. No latent prints were developed. I did not collect any DNA swabs from the weapon. That item will be submitted to the Department of Justice Crime Lab for that process at a later date. I separated the ammunition and the magazine from that item and labeled them item CF-12A. I released both items to Property Supervisor Scott King at 1542 hours. No further action was taken.
