On 12-31-2013 about 1133hrs. A call of an Officer involved shooting that just occurred was broadcast at Arlington Park in the City and County of Riverside. I responded from 8181 Lincoln St. and arrived on scene at 1145hrs. Upon arrival I was directed to the North side of the park to close the park down. I positioned myself approximately 200 feet West of Van Buren Bl. along the South curb of Hayes St. While there I saw a Male Hispanic W/Benavante sitting on top of a mountain bike North East of the tennis courts. I asked him if he saw what had happened and he told me "No" I then asked what he was doing and he told me he was riding his Bicycle down Van Buren Bl (North) along the West sidewalk when he saw a male and female arguing in the park. He said he didn't pay much attention to it because it wasn't any of his business. He then said they were yelling loud and the Male was pulling at her. He then pointed to the subject laying face on the South side of the tennis courts. W/Benavante then said a Police car pulled up on the grass behind the Male and Female that were arguing and he continued to ride toward Hayes St. When he reached the South West corner cont.

He then motioned that the Police car entered the park in a North West direction and said he believed the shots were fired toward the building West of the tennis courts.
