Details:

On 06-11-13, I was working as a uniformed police sergeant with the Riverside Police Department in the City and County of Riverside. I was in the area of Adams and Lincoln when I heard an officer (Later determined to be Officer Garcia) go on scene of a traffic collision. Dispatched advised Officer Garcia that reports from citizens advised a Black male was seen fleeing from the crashed vehicle with a gun. The male was described wearing white shorts and a black tee-shirt. He was last seen heading towards the Chevron gas station (west bound from the crashed vehicle located at 3476 Van Buren).

I responded to the location by heading west on Lincoln and then north on Van Buren. When I arrived in the area, I parked my police car on the north east side of the Chevron and asked for responding unit to meet me at the location. Officers Barnhill, Mann, Mecck, Dilsa, Hibbard and Cleary met me at the location. Once the team was formed, I had dispatch contact the store employees of the Chevron and exit the store. I was concerned that the subject seen with the gun might have entered the location and could potentially take hostages.

Dispatched contacted the store employees and had them exit the store. I directed the employees to our location. As they approached us, I asked them if anyone was inside the store. Both employees were unsure if anyone was inside the store but told us they were the only two employees. I asked the employees if they saw anyone in the parking lot. One of the employees told me he believed he saw a subject go to the rear of the building along the south side of the business.

I was concerned that there might be additional people inside the gas station. I was also concerned that the subject might have made it to the rear of the business and fled into a residential neighborhood that was just west of the business. I decided to deploy two teams to clear the west side of the business and then clear the interior of the business to verify if the subject was still at the location or if he had fled into the neighborhood.

I divided the officers into two teams that would move up together along the north side of the parking lot. One team consisted of Officer Hibbard and his K-9 partner "Billy", Officer Cleary and Officer Disla. They were assigned to cover the front (east side) of the store while the

second team consisting of Officer Macek, Officer Mann, Officer Barnhill and myself would search the north west side of the business and then the west side.

As the two teams of officers approached the location, the first team held on the north east corner of the building. I moved with second team and searched the bushes, dumpster area and tree line on the north side. Once the area was searched, I moved to the northwest corner of the building. As I peered around the corner, I immediately saw a light skinned Black male standing with his back against the building and was facing west. The male was wearing white shorts and a black tee shirt. This matched the description of the subject seen with a gun. The rear area was well lite by overhead lighting. Between me and the subject were two wrought iron fences. The suspect appeared to be approximately 25 yards from where I was. I immediately identified myself as a police officer and ordered the subject to show his hands. The subject looked in my direction. I noticed his right hand was down to his right side and I could not see his left hand. I ordered the subject to lie on the ground. The subject looked away from me over his left shoulder, then back at towards me. I again ordered the subject to show me his hands and get on the ground. The subject did not comply and did not move.

I gave a third order to the subject to show his hands and go to the ground. The subject again looked over his left shoulder and appeared to begin to raise his hands. The subject then turned to his left and began to run southbound along the west side of the building. I advised the other officers of my team the subject was running southbound. The information was relayed to the other officers over the police radio.

I advised the officers with me to hold their positions in case the subject doubled back towards us. A very short time later I heard approximately 10 to 15 gunshots that sounded like they were coming from south of my location. I had the officers with me hold their positions and I moved to the east side of the building and to the second team to check on them. As I moved south bound along the east side of the building, I saw Officer Hibbard, Officer Cleary and Officer Disla near the south east corner of the building. All the officers were standing partially in the driveway area on the southeast parking lot. As I approached their position, I saw the same subject I observed at the rear of the building lying in a dirt area south of the parking lot. The subject was lying face down. His head was towards the west and his feet were to the east. His hands and forearms were under his body and towards his waist area.

Because the subject was still believed to be armed, I moved the officers back behind two cars that were parked on the south side of the building for cover. I immediately requested medical aid to respond and stage in the area until the subject could safely be taken into custody. Since the subject had his arms under his body near his waist and was still believed to be armed, I requested a marked unit to our location. I was going to use the marked unit to move up and provide cover as we approached the subject.

A marked police unit driven by Officer Southard drove up just in front of our location. I had Officer Southard angle the unit, placing the unit between the officers and the subject. A second marked police unit was deployed and placed just south and east of Officer Southard's vehicle. I moved Officer Hibbard, his K-9 partner "Billy", and three officers to the front of Officer Southard's unit. The unit was then moved forward, providing cover for the officers and allowing us to approach in a safe manner. The unit was stopped approximately 25 feet from the subject. Officer Hibbard gave a few K-9 announcements and ordered the subject to show his hands. The subject did not move.

Since the subject was lying face down, we could not see his hands, a firearm had not been located and the subject was still believed to be armed, the decision was made to deploy the police K-9. Once the K-9 was deployed, I noticed a black revolver near the subject's right hand. The team of officers moved up to the subject while the K-9 was engaged. Officer Zackowski used his foot and stepped on the firearm while the subject was pulled away from it. Officers placed handcuffs on the subject and moved him to the driveway area and away from the firearm. The firearm was left where it was found.

Medical aid was then directed to our location to attend to the subject. At that point the area was secured and I conducted a safety brief with the officers to determine which officers discharged their firearms, in what direction and how many rounds they believed they fired. I then directed officers to search for evidence and secure any that was located.

Officer Hibbard was transported from the scene to the Magnolia Police Station (to be interviewed by detectives) by Officer Stucker. Officer Disla was transported to the Magnolia Police Station by Officer Zackowski.

I remained at the scene and provided a briefing to the responding detectives. I remained at the scene until I was relieved by Sgt. Lambert.
