On 6/11/13 I responded to the Chevron Station at 3476 Van Buren Blvd. in Riverside regarding an Officer Involved Shooting. I was assigned to investigate as Co-Case Agent with Detective Wheeler. After observing the crime scene, I went to the Magnolia Station to interview witnesses.

Interview of Officer Eric Garcia

Officer Garcia was interviewed at the Magnolia Station. I told him he was being interviewed as a witness to the Officer Involved Shooting. The interview was digitally recorded and later downloaded to the department server.

Officer Garcia said he was working uniformed patrol as call sign "Adam 429". He said he was traveling northbound on Van Buren Blvd. when he saw a vehicle parked on the center island in front of the Chevron Station. He said the car appeared to have crashed. As he approached the vehicle, he contacted the driver who was out of the vehicle and on the passenger side looking at the damage. He advised radio dispatch that he was checking on a traffic collision.

Officer Garcia said he then saw a black male walking across Van Buren Blvd. towards the Chevron parking lot. He said he believed the male came from the crashed vehicle because he was walking away from it. He said that the male was not walking fast and did not appear to be fleeing from the vehicle. He said the male was wearing a blue shirt and tan shorts.

Officer Garcia began asking the driver what happened. He believed that the driver may have been under the influence of drugs due to his behavior. He began to pat down the driver for any weapons. At this time, radio dispatch advised him that there was a "Man with a gun" call on the freeway. Radio dispatch advised that witnesses saw a vehicle crash on Van Buren and a black male get out of the car and was walking with a handgun in his hand.

Officer Garcia immediately realized that the driver and the black male walking towards Chevron were involved in the "Man with a gun" call and advised radio dispatch that he was with the suspects. He radioed that the male walking towards the Chevron was possibly the man with the gun. He directed his attention to the driver who was still at the car and handcuffed him. He lost site of the suspect with the possible gun.

Officer Garcia said assisting units arrived and a group of officers approached the Chevron to look for the suspect. A short time later he heard Sgt. Tipre on the radio advise that they had the suspect at gunpoint to the rear of the Chevron.

Officer Garcia was still with the driver of the car in the center of Van Buren Blvd. He saw the same suspect who walked away from the vehicle, come out from the rear of the Chevron on the south side. The suspect was walking towards three officers who were covering the front of the business on the south side. He saw the suspect with something in his right hand. He believed the item in the suspect's hand was a handgun by the way he was holding it, but he did not see an actual gun. He said the suspect was walking towards the officers and raised his hand, with the item, at the officers. He said the suspect's left side was facing the officers and the suspect brought his right hand up and out towards the officers. He then heard a gunshot. He immediately thought that the suspect had shot at the officers.

Officer Garcia said that approximately one second passed after the first gunshot, then he heard 3 to 5 shots in quick succession. He saw the suspect run in south towards the fence where he

was found on the ground. He said he did not see the suspect fall to the ground. He did not hear any shots after the 3 to 5 shots.

Officer Garcia said he did not hear any voices from either the officers or the suspect.

Officer Garcia said he secured the driver and assisted officers with securing the suspect who had been shot.

Officer Garcia had no further information.
