**SUMMARY/RESULTS**

The submitted firearms, Items BF-01 and BF-03, functioned properly during examination and test firing.

**EVIDENCE**

The following evidence was submitted to the Laboratory by Fuller of the Riverside Police Department on 06/12/2013:

BF-01	Glock Model 22, .40 S&W caliber semiautomatic pistol, S/N FFY802
BF-02	One loose round and one magazine containing five rounds (all rounds are Winchester brand .40 S&W caliber with jacketed hollow point bullets)
BF-03	Smith & Wesson Model M&P-15, 5.56x45mm caliber semiautomatic rifle, S/N SW05042
BF-04	One loose round and one magazine containing 21 rounds (all rounds are Winchester brand 5.56x45mm caliber with jacketed bullets)

**EXAMINATION**

Item BF-01 was identified as a Glock Model 22 semiautomatic pistol chambered to fire .40 S&W caliber ammunition. The pistol's disconnect and safeties were found to be working. The trigger pull measured 6 pounds. The magazine, Item BF-02, was submitted containing five rounds. The magazine's capacity was determined to be 15 rounds. The pistol was test fired using this magazine and three rounds from it. The pistol functioned properly during examination and test firing.

Item BF-03 was identified as a Smith & Wesson Model M&P-15 semiautomatic rifle chambered to fire 5.56x45mm caliber ammunition. The rifle's disconnect and safety were found to be working. The trigger pull measured 7 ¼ pounds. The magazine, Item BF-04, was submitted containing 21 rounds. The magazine's capacity was determined to be 30 rounds. The rifle was test fired using this magazine and three rounds from it. Only the cartridge cases were retained. The rifle functioned properly during examination and test firing.

**DISPOSITION**

The test fires were labeled Items TF-BF-01 and TF-BF-03. The test fires and all remaining items will be returned to the appropriate agency.
