**Narrative**

On 01-17-09 at approximately 2000 hrs I was called by Sgt Masson who asked me to respond to the area of Mulberry and 1<sup>st</sup> in the City of Riverside for an Officer Involved Shooting (OIS). I arrived and saw that the entire area was cordoned off with yellow crime scene tape and uniformed officers were stationed on the perimeter. Sgt Masson told me that Det Wheeler would be the case agent and Det Cobb was assisting him. I was assigned to process the scene with Evid Tech Fuller.

I attended a briefing given by patrol supervisor Sgt Corbett and patrol Officer Boulerville. They told us that officers responded to the area for a man with a gun threatening his family at 3468 Spruce. The suspect took off on foot and was later reported to be in the area of 2841 Mulberry. Officers located him there and followed him south on Mulberry as he pointed a gun to his own head. After walking a short distance the suspect took a firing position and pointed his weapon at the officers. Officer Dave Taylor was on-scene and he fired his duty pistol, striking the suspect. The suspect was pronounced dead at the scene at 2003 hrs by Dr. Lamb at Riverside Community Hospital via electronic strip sent by paramedics

The area the shooting occurred in on Mulberry is a residential neighborhood bordered by the 91 freeway between 1<sup>st</sup> Street and Poplar.

Det Wheeler and Det Cobb took Evid Tech Fuller, Evid Tech Lane and me on a walk-through of the scene. They pointed out the body of the suspect lying on the west dirt shoulder of Mulberry, just south of the property line to 2855 Mulberry. They then showed us three marked Riverside Police Units parked on Mulberry north of the suspect. The lead unit had the driver's side spotlight illuminating the area of the suspect was lying in and the passenger door was open. They also pointed out two expended casings lying under the front wheel area of the unit parked behind the first.

The entire scene was videotaped and photographed by the evidence techs prior to any search or evidence collection. The following is what we found during a search of the area.

**West dirt shoulder of Mulberry, just south of 2855 Mulberry**

- The body of S-Hyatt was found lying on his stomach near a chain-link fence on the dirt shoulder off of Mulberry. He appeared to have an obvious head wound. His head was pointing south and his feet north. His hands were handcuffed behind his back. He was wearing a white t-shirt with "Mudsharks" written on it, blue jeans with a brown belt, and tan and white shoes. Deputy Coroner Ferris searched his person and located a yellow metal chain and cross, misc pictures and cards, a bag of loose tobacco and cash in the amount of \$11.38. Deputy Ferris seized these items and gave me a receipt.

- A Beretta Tomcat .32 caliber, semi-auto handgun, serial # [REDACTED] (1) live .32 caliber round was miss-fed into the firing chamber, leaving the slide slightly open. (3) live .32 caliber rounds were found in the inserted magazine. The safety was off and the hammer was slightly back. This gun was located under the stomach area of the suspect when he was moved by the Coroner. R.O Info on gun. Debelling, Warren DOB: [REDACTED] 35836 42<sup>nd</sup> St East, Palmdale CA

- Medical Defibrillator left by emergency medical personnel. The leads were attached to the suspect's torso. This was photographed and later released to RFD.

**Mulberry, just south of 2855 Mulberry**

Three marked Riverside Police cars were parked on Mulberry facing south, about 120 feet north of where the suspect was lying.

- Unit #3749 was the lead unit. The passenger door was wide open. The driver's side spotlight was on and illuminating the area the suspect was lying in.

- Unit #3631 was the second unit, and it was parked behind #3749. (2) expended .40 caliber casings were located under the front wheel area of this car.

- Unit #3619 was the third unit, and it was located parked behind #3631. Shotguns [REDACTED] were found in the trunk of this car. They were charted and found to be fully loaded with 12 gauge slugs. It did not appear that they were fired (see charting report by Evid Tech Fuller).

### **Mulberry and Poplar**

Three marked Riverside Police cars were parked in the area of Mulberry and Poplar. They were quite a distance from the shooting scene

- Units #3748 and #3770 were parked on the south side of Poplar facing east, just west of Mulberry
- Unit #3909 was parked on the west side of Mulberry at Poplar facing south.

### **2974 Lime**

2974 Lime is located southwest of the shooting scene across an open lot and an alley. The east facing garage door of the unattached garage was in the line of fire given Officer Taylor's shooting position. On 01-18-09, the day after the incident, Sgt Capen and Sgt Daley walked the area during daylight and located a possible bullet strike in the garage door at 2974 Lime. On 01-19-09 I contacted O1 McBride and he told me that it was new damage. He also said he located an expended round on the floor of the garage near his pickup truck. O1 McBride told me that he lives by himself and works late hours during the week, but he has Fridays off. He said I could come over on the next friday, 01-23-09, to look in his garage and recover any evidence.

On 01-23-09 at 0800 hrs I contacted O1 McBride at his house and he took me to the garage. He told me that he was home that night and he thought he heard two shots. He found the damage and the expended round the next day and didn't touch anything. I saw the hole in the upper right corner of the east facing garage door and an expended round on the floor of the garage. Evid Tech Fuller responded and photographed and collected the evidence.
