1 **Interviews:**

2 During the week of January 19th, I received a call from O/Anita Hyatt stating that she was the step-
3 mother of S/Russell Hyatt and that she would like to talk with me about the shooting. A meeting was set
4 for January 22nd, at CIB where I spoke in general with Anita about the shooting and answered some
5 questions she had. Some of her questions about the shooting could not be answered at that time. She
6 provided some background on S/Hyatt and the problems he had in his life leading up to the shooting.
7

8 **O/Anita Hyatt:**

9 Anita has been around S/Russell Hyatt for several years and knows him very well. She is currently
10 married to Russell's father and the two of them have tried to help S/Hyatt with the various problems and
11 arrests he has dealt with in his life. Anita did not think very highly of S/Hyatt's wife, V/Iris Hyatt,
12 stating that she made things very difficult for S/Hyatt in their Spruce St home. As a result of S/Hyatt's
13 drug abuse to drinking problems, in Anita's opinion, Iris made life hard on S/Hyatt.
14

15 On January 17th, 2009 at approximately 1330 hrs, Anita received a call from Iris who told her that
16 S/Hyatt called asking her to pick him up from the rehabilitation facility he was living at in Indio, CA.
17 Iris said she refused to pick him up and told him to get a ride.
18

19 At approximately 1800 hrs, Anita received another call from Iris who sounded 'hysterical'. Iris said
20 S/Hyatt was at her home on Spruce St and that S/Hyatt was trying to take a truck they owned and he
21 wanted his wallet. A short time later, Anita called Iris to see what was happening. Iris told her that
22 S/Hyatt had left the residence and the police had come to the house. Some time later that night, Iris
23 called Anita and her husband (S/Hyatt's father) and told them that S/Hyatt had been shot.
24

25 Anita said S/Hyatt has been in trouble his entire life and he has been in jail on numerous occasions. She
26 added that S/Hyatt has threatened police officers before and has made statements to her that he wanted
27 to commit suicide by having a police officer shoot him. S/Hyatt told Anita he knew that if he pointed a
28 gun at a police officer, they would have to shoot him. Anita was not completely surprised to hear that
29 S/Hyatt had been shot by a police officer.
30

31 On Tuesday January 27th, I spoke with O/Warren Debelling about a message he had left for me. Warren
32 had called to say that he was missing a .32 caliber handgun and wondered if it was the gun used by
33 S/Hyatt during the shooting on January 17th. A records check of the gun (a Berretta .32 caliber "Tom
34 Cat" Ser# [REDACTED]) found in S/Hyatt's possession the night of the shooting, showed it was
35 registered to Warren but was not reported as stolen. I called Warren back and interviewed him about
36 how S/Hyatt came to be in possession of the gun.
37

38 **O/Warren Debelling:**

39 Warren confirmed the model type and serial number of the handgun stating that he had purchased it for
40 home protection years ago. He had no idea that the gun was missing since he does not take it out very
41 much. The last time he saw this gun was between Thanksgiving and Christmas time in 2008. He had
42 taken the gun from a hidden drawer in his dresser and put it on top of a hutch in his living room during
43 that time. He did this due to some problems his girlfriend was having with an ex-boyfriend.

1 His girlfriend at the time, Teresa Hyatt (sister of S/Hyatt), knew he had this handgun. He could not
2 remember if he returned the gun to the drawer at some time after the problems stopped. Warren said
3 Teresa knew where he hid the gun in the dresser. He could remember at least five times in the recent
4 past that S/Hyatt had come to his home to visit Teresa. He could not remember if he ever showed the
5 gun to S/Hyatt. Warren felt he might have seen it during one of the visits or Teresa might have shown it
6 to him. He and Teresa are not dating.

7
8 Once Warren heard about the shooting involving S/Hyatt, he felt the need to check on his gun. He could
9 not find it. He tried to report the gun as missing to Palmdale P.D. two days after the shooting but said he
10 refused to give much information to the officers who came to take the report. He claimed they were
11 unprofessional with him. Warren decided to call RPD to see if in fact his gun had been used by S/Hyatt
12 during the shooting. The last time Warren saw the gun, it was loaded with a full magazine. He did not
13 remember purchasing two magazines for the gun but said he found a full magazine at his home when he
14 began to search for the gun. Warren did not know S/Hyatt very well. He only knew that S/Hyatt had
15 been 'on the run' from parole in the past. He had nothing more to add on the case.

16
17 On February 6, 2009 I had L.A. County Sheriff/ Palmdale Station fax me a copy of the radio call relating
18 to Warren's attempt to report his gun as missing. This call for service occurred on January 5, 2009.

21 On Friday February 6th, I spoke with Agt. Doug Johnson of the California State Parole Dept. He was the
22 first person to call 911 the night of January 17th.

23
24 Agt. D. Johnson:

25 Agt. Johnson has been S/Hyatt's parole agent for a while. He was aware of S/Hyatt's drug and alcohol
26 problems which caused S/Hyatt to be placed in a rehabilitation facility in Indo, CA. Agt. Johnson has had
27 contact with S/Hyatt's wife, Iris, in the past.

28
29 On January 17th, at around 1700 hrs, Agt. Johnson received a phone call from Iris who said S/Hyatt had
30 been kicked out of the Indo facility for drinking. Agt. Johnson did some follow up on this information
31 and found out that S/Hyatt had been sent out of the program but that the staff was planning to re-admit
32 him on following Monday. Later that same night, Agt. Johnson got another call from Iris at around
33 1750 hrs. Iris was scared and told him that S/Hyatt had come to her home with a gun and he was
34 threatening to shoot himself. Agt. Johnson told her to immediately call 911 and get the police enroute to
35 her home. Before she hung up, Iris said S/Hyatt had pointed his gun at the family while he was leaving.
36 She was shocked that he would point his gun at their son.

37
38 Agt. Johnson hung up with Iris and called RPD dispatch to report what Iris had told him. He advised
39 dispatch that he was S/Hyatt's parole officer and that S/Hyatt was on parole for violence toward police.
40 Agt. Johnson never responded to the scene of either incident.
