

4 Source of Activity:

5 On Friday September 13, 2013 at approximately 2145 hours, I was working in full 6 uniform, assigned as METRO-4 for the Riverside Police Department. While on duty I 7 responded to assist patrol officers reference an officer involved shooting that had just 8 taken place in the area of 10th St. / Sedgwick Ave. located in the city and county of 9 Riverside.

11 Observations:

Upon arrival, I noticed that several officers were already on-scene and a perimeter had already been established with yellow police tape. I also noticed a crowd forming at the above intersection. As I walked through the crowd in order to assist officer's on-scene, I noticed two Hispanic males in the crown that appeared to be agitated but I dismissed it as on-lookers in the crowd. At the time I did not know who these two individuals were or how they were involved in the incident.

Shortly after entering the scene, I noticed that one of the males (later ID'd as Sstarted cursing towards the officer's who were inside the scene by stating "fuck them, they can't keep us out". At this point I believed he was attempting to possibly incite the crowd by causing a disturbance and entering the secured scene.

- I focused on S and noticed that he attempted to cross through the yellow crime scene tape by attempting to walk underneath it and into the secured scene (violation of 148 P.C.). I then went to contact S in order to place him into custody for the above violation and advised him to turn around and place his hands behind his back. S refused by walking away from me and stating "fuck no, what for".

As I continued to walk towards him, he backed directly into Officer Macias who grabbed
 S-Interference of placing him into custody.

I then forced S and up against a parked police unit in order to gain better control of him. S-more continued to resist by keeping his left arm stiff and not complying with my orders to place his hand behind his back. During this process, S control lost his footing / balance and fell to the ground as he continued to resist.



I applied my body weight onto his upper torso as I lost my grasp of his left arm. I 1 immediately pinned the right side of his head directly onto the ground with my left 2 forearm in order to keep him down to the ground and regain control of his left arm. 3 and gained control of both arms and Officer Macias assisted me in controlling S 4 was arrested without further incident and placed in placed handcuffs on him. During the photo's I observed what appeared to be old injuries on his right 20 elbow and right knee. I asked him if those injuries were from today and he advised they 21 were old injuries. I then asked him if he had any complaints of pain and he pointed to the 22 right side of his head. 23 24 Linspected the right side of his head and observed redness directly above his right ear 25 which was caused from the head pin during the use of force. S-26 aid. 27 28 , I asked him if he was present during the incident (officer Prior to releasing S-29 involved shooting) or if he saw anything. He stated that he was down the street and heard 30 several shots and then went to see what was going on. 31 32 was released to the care of O-De La Torre while on scene. 33 S-34 Sgt. Warren was on-scene and was advised of the use of force. 35
