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Narrative:

On 01-07-11 at about 1624 hours, I responded to the area of 10745 Cypress Ave, to assist with the crowd control and investigation of an officer involved shooting. When I arrived at the location, I was assigned to speak with people in the area in an attempt to locate possible witnesses.

I saw O1/Calderilla standing across the street from the above residence in the front yard of [REDACTED]. I spoke with O1/Calderilla and she told me that she lived at [REDACTED]. O1/Calderilla told me that at about 1620 hours, she was standing in her back yard when she heard about four or five gunshots. When she heard the gunshots she went inside her house and waited inside until she saw several police vehicles outside. When she saw the police vehicles, she exited her house and stood in her front yard. O1/Calderilla told me that other than hearing the gunshots she did not see or hear anything else regarding the incident.

After speaking with O1/Calderilla, I spoke with O2/Rosales who was standing on the side of the street about 50 yards west of 10745 Cypress Ave. O2/Rosales told me that he was eating dinner inside of his residence when he heard loud noises that sounded like firecrackers outside. A few minutes after hearing the noise, O1/Calderilla heard the police helicopter and several sirens. O2/Rosales decided to walk to where the police were to see what was going on. O2/Rosales told me that other than hearing the gunfire, he did not see or hear anything else regarding the incident.
