62. Narrative of Supplemental Report On 1/7/12 at 1623 hours I heard officers transmit via the radio "shots fired." Dispatch advised officers were on scene at 10745 Cypress for a family disturbance call and made the transmission. I arrived on scene and saw S/1 Ledezma laying on his right side in the yard of 10745 Cypress he was being treated by RFD personnel. I briefly spoke to the officers involved Officers Putnam, Espinoza and Miranda and they gave me the following safety information. Between the three officers approximately seventeen rounds were fired from their duty weapons in an easterly direction. In that direction was a detached garage behind the residence located at 10745 Cypress. Detective Brian Jones did a safety sweep of the garage and the residence to make sure no one was injured or in need of r tical attention. The officers quickly showed me the area where the incident occurred. They pointed out a two foot white pipe, a Riverside Police Department electronic control device and a knife. The items were on the ground within an approximate 25 foot diameter of where S/1 Ledezma was being treated. They advised me there was a second steel pipe believed to be near where S/1 Ledezma was being treated however I couldn't see the pipe from my position. I immediately ordered officers to put crime scene tape around what was identified as the crime scene. After S/1 Ledezma was taken to the ambulance from the crime scene the scene was sealed off. I posted officers at both entrances to the yard and three around the crime scene and residence.

Assisting officers began making contact at all the residences surrounding 10745 Cypress. There instructions were to identify everyone home at the time of the incident and interview any additional witnesses or assist any injured citizens. Officer Schmitz was assigned to ride with S/1 Ledezma in the ambulance to Riverside Community Hospital. He was told to audio tape his entire contact with S/1 Ledezma.

Sergeants Toussaint and Hardin assisted with arranging transportation of the involved officers and witnesses to the Magnolia Station. Lt. Blomdahl arrived on scene and after he was briefed he initiated a Persons Detective callout. Upon there arrival I briefed the investigators on the incident with information I had at the time. I left the scene and went to the Magnolia Station at approximately 2045 hours.

At approximately 2100 hours I instructed Detective Jones and Officers Leone and Anguire to enter the file number into the COBAN systems of unit #3925 and Unit #3931(the two units Officers Putnam, Espinoza and Miranda were assigned) and transport the units to the Lincoln Street Station. There the COBAN video/audio would automatically download to the server. So the video could be viewed by investigators. The officers did as instructed and transported both units to the Lincoln Station.
