Narrative of Supplemental Report:

V-2 -Officer Jeffery Putnam #1450, Riverside Police Officer; (Glock .40 caliber, Model 22, Serial# [REDACTED])
V-3 -Officer Ramon Espinoza #1691, Riverside Police Officer; (Glock .40 caliber, Model 22, Serial # [REDACTED]). Back-up weapon (S & W Airweight .38 caliber revolver, Serial#- [REDACTED]).

I was present on 01-07-2012 when ID Tech Ellis took photos of all three officers and charted their weapons.

V-1 Miranda (2215 hours) had nine (9) live .40 caliber bullets in the magazine removed from his weapon. There was one live .40 caliber bullet removed from the chamber. V-1 Miranda had two full (15) .40 caliber bullet magazines in his magazine pouch.

V-2 Putnam (2230 hours) had his weapon fully loaded (one chamber, 15 in bullet magazine .40 caliber). V-2 Putnam advised he had performed a tactical reload. The bullet magazine V-Putnam removed from his weapon after firing had 6 live .40 caliber bullets. V-1 Putnam had an additional full (15) magazine in his bullet pouch.

V-3 Espinoza (2245 hours) had eleven (11) .40 caliber bullets in the magazine removed from his weapon. There was one .40 caliber bullet removed from the chamber. V-3 Espinoza had two full (15) .40 caliber magazines in his magazine pouch. V-3 Espinoza had an additional full (15) .40 caliber magazine in his rear pants pocket. V-3 Espinoza kept his back-up weapon in his left front pocket. This weapon had not been removed from V-3 Espinoza's pocket during the shooting and had five (5) live, 38 caliber bullets still in the 5 shot cylinder.
