Narrative of Supplemental Report:

On 1/9/2012, I received a verbal request from Senior Forensic Technician T. Ellis to document the autopsy of Suspect: David Ledezma (DOB: [REDACTED]). On 1/11/12, at 0850 hours, I arrived at the Riverside Sheriff-Coroner Morgue (800 South Redlands, Perris). I contacted Detective R. Wheeler, and identified what evidence needed to be collected. At 0925 hours, the autopsy began. The autopsy was attended by Pathologist M. Fajardo, Riverside Sheriff Forensic Technician J. Frisby, and Coroner Technician A. Maldonado. I took (195) digital photographs of the autopsy. At 1055 hours, the autopsy concluded. I took possession of Evidence Items #WM01-WM07 from For. Tech. Frisby. See attached Property Report and Photo Logs. At 1115 hours, I cleared the morgue, and transported Items #WM01-WM07 to the Magnolia Station. I secured Items #WM01-WM07 in the evidence vault, and downloaded the digital photographs to a secure file format.

On 1/17/12, at 0838 hours, I released Evidence Items #WM01-WM07 to Magnolia Station Police Property Specialist S. Robinson. No further action was taken.
