62. Narrative of Supplemental Report  
On 02-23-15 at about 2128 hours, I was working as a patrol sergeant for the Riverside Police Department. An officer put out on the police radio channel-1, "Shots fired, shots fired." I immediately started to respond to the area of 2865 Prospect. Upon arrival, an update came out that the possible suspect was at 2786 Pleasant and had fired a gun in the residence. I was in the immediate area and responded. I saw the occupants of the house outside in the street yelling and stating the guy was in the house in far back bedroom and had fired a gun inside the residence. I made entry into the residence with about four other officers. The residence was quickly searched and we located a subject down in the southeast corner of the house. The subject appeared to be a Hispanic male. He was lying on his back just inside the bedroom, with his feet at the door and his hands and arms out away from his body. The subject had no movement. Medical aid was immediately summoned. A shot gun was located to the right of the suspect's body, at the foot of the bed. The male subject had what appeared to be a self-inflicted wound to his face. Officer Pap st... with the suspect while the rest of the entry team turned around and completed a secondary search of the residence.

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RFD responded and was entering the residence when Sergeant Perkins directed me to go and secure the crime scene, where the original call and officer involved shooting occurred at 2865 Prospect.

Upon arrival at 2865 Prospect, I located Officer Weddle and Detective Lackey. I spoke to Officer Weddle and asked him the public safety statement. I confirmed he was okay and was not injured. He estimated he only shot one round from his duty weapon and was unsure how many Officer Macias fired. He showed me the strike marks of a round that penetrated a metal shed. Following my questions, I assigned K-9 Officer Hibbard to stay with Officer Weddle until an officer was free to transport him to Magnolia Street Station.

Sergeant Wilson was on scene with the PACT Team at 2865 Prospect. His team conducted a safety sweep of the residence and the property.

During the sweep of the property, shell casings were located in the rear yard and marked for the detectives and evidence collection team.

I assumed control of the scene as the scene supervisor. I conducted the walk through with the detectives when they arrived. At about 0430 hours I was relieved by Sergeant Perkins and cleared the scene.
