8 **Scene Description/Observations:**

10 Grove is a north/south city street. Pleasant St. is an east/west city street. Officer Ouk parked our police  
11 unit (3140) on Pleasant St., just west of Grove, facing west.  
12

13 **Narrative:**

15 On 2-23-15, partner Officer Ouk and I were assigned to the North NPC as “Bike 1.” We were assigned  
16 to the “Cal-Chiefs” event being held downtown. At approximately 2140 hours, we were parked at the  
17 intersection of Main St. and 6<sup>th</sup> St. when we suddenly heard, “236, shots fired” broadcasted. Officer Ouk  
18 began driving towards the East NPC when I heard over the radio that the suspect was still armed with a  
19 shotgun and he was in the area of Prospect and Grove. I then heard that a unit was needed in the area of  
20 Pleasant and Grove.

22 Officer Ouk drove our police unit south on Grove from 14<sup>th</sup> St. He then stopped our unit on Pleasant,  
23 just west of Grove. We exited our unit and began scanning the area for suspects. Officer Romero was on  
24 scene and advised the suspect was possibly running east (we were on Pleasant, west of Grove when we  
25 contacted Officer Romero). Officers Ouk, Pap, Camp, and I began searching the general area around  
26 Pleasant and Grove. I then heard a small bang and we all looked at each other. We all acknowledged  
27 hearing the bang but were not sure what it was. We all agreed the sound appeared to be coming east from  
28 our location. We began searching eastbound on Pleasant St. on the south side of the street. As we were  
29 walking, we noticed several individuals (both Black males and females from various ages) exiting the  
30 front door of 2786 Pleasant St. They appeared to be scared and began yelling that someone was inside the  
31 house armed with a “gun.” We told the residents that everybody needed to exit the house as we began to  
32 approach the residence. One subject yelled out that his “grandpa” was still inside the residence. More  
33 subjects exited the residence and one of them stated, “He shot himself” while another subject yelled he  
34 had a gun and was in a back room (I was unable to determine what subject said what as multiple people  
35 were yelling at the same time).

37 Because the occupants said there was a subject armed with a gun and the fact that we did not know if  
38 any victims were still in the residence, we decided to conduct a sweep of the house for the suspect and  
39 victims. Officers Ouk, Pap, Camp and I entered the residence and began walking southbound through the  
40 living room. Officer Camp held on the rooms located on the west side of the residence while Officers  
41 Ouk, Pap and I continued southbound towards the kitchen. We passed the kitchen which opened up into a  
42 room on the east portion of the house. We then continued southbound into the hallway which is when I  
43 smelled what I believed to be gunpowder. We cleared the rooms as we walked down the hallway. I then  
44 noticed a male subject (later identified as S1) lying on the ground inside a room at the end of the hallway.  
45 We continued our approach and S1 appeared to have a gunshot wound to his head. S1 was lying on his

1 back and a shotgun was on the ground next to him. We entered and cleared the room and did not locate  
2 anyone else inside the residence.

3  
4 Officer Ouk and I exited the residence and later blocked traffic at the intersection of Prospect Ave. and  
5 Grove.

6  
7 Sgt. Stump later approached us and asked us to sit on the house while Officers Pap and Camp attempted  
8 to contact neighbors. We remained on scene until we were relieved by Officer Rivera on 2-24-15 at  
9 approximately 0015 hours.
