**NARRATIVE:**

On 02-23-14, at approximately 2140 hours, partner Officer Camp and I were working uniformed patrol in the downtown Riverside area as assignment C110. We heard unit C236, later identified as Officers Macias and Weddle, broadcast "shot fired" over the radio. I heard an unknown officer advise that the suspect was armed with a shotgun and rifle and was fleeing north on foot from the location of 2865 Prospect St. Officer Camp and I responded to the location to assist.

We parked our vehicle at the intersection of Grove St and Pleasant St to help create a perimeter. Officer E. Romero was already in the area and told me he observed the suspect running through backyards on the south side of Pleasant St in an easterly direction. Officer's Ouk and Serrato were also in the area and we joined up with them to help set up the containment perimeter.

After being on scene for a few minutes, I heard a muffled bang. I spoke with the other officers on scene and we all agreed it sounded like it had come from east of our location. We began walking east on Pleasant St to investigate. As we rounded the corner from Grove and onto Pleasant, I could hear several people shouting. I looked down the street and saw several subjects running out of a residence on the south side of the street. I later learned the address of the location was 2786 Pleasant St. I could hear several of the subjects shouting that someone with a gun had ran into their house. I heard another person shout "some guy is shooting in there". We moved to the front of the residence and told the subjects on the lawn and in the doorway to get out of the house. An unknown female was crying and screaming that her grandfather was still inside the residence with the subject who had a gun. I heard another person say that the subject may have shot himself inside.

Based on the fact the suspect had just been involved in a shooting with officers, because I heard a gunshot coming from the residence, and because there were possibly other potential victims inside the house, I believed there was an exigency to get inside the residence subdue the suspect. Officers Serrato, Ouk, Camp and I formed a search team and made entry into 2786 Pleasant St. As we were making our way through the house I could smell what I believed was a freshly fired gun. I could also see smoke coming from a back bedroom of the house. As we reached the back bedroom of the house I could see a subject lying on the ground through the open door of the room.

The suspect was lying on his back with his feet towards the door and his head towards the south side of the room. I could see what appeared to be a black pump-action shotgun on the ground near his right hand. The suspect appeared to be a Hispanic male approximately 50-60 years old. He was wearing a long sleeved gray shirt and blue jeans. The suspect appeared to have a gunshot wound to his face. The suspect looked obviously deceased due to the major facial trauma and I did not see any movement of his chest. I asked the suspect several times if he could hear me and I received no response. I immediately told the assisting officers on scene to call for medical aid. I maintained cover on the suspect until the rest of the residence was safely cleared. I stayed in the room with the suspect until Sergeant Perkins relieved me and told me to leave the house.

After leaving the residence Sergeant Stump assigned me to go door to door and check for witnesses.

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I checked the following residences and received no response at the door: 2795 and 2771 Pleasant. 2779 Pleasant was a vacant house. The resident at [REDACTED] (O/Calderon) was sleeping and said she did not see or hear anything. The resident at [REDACTED] was also sleeping and said she did not hear anything.

Sergeant Stump assigned Officer Camp and I to conduct a sweep for evidence down Pleasant St from Grove to Forest St. I did not locate any evidence. Sergeant Stump then assigned us to maintain our perimeter position at Grove and Pleasant until we were cleared by Sergeant Perkins on 02-24-15 at approximately 0130 hours.
