6 **Narrative:**

7 On 02/23/15 at approximately 2140 hours, partner Officer Serrato and I were working a uniformed
8 assignment in a marked police car in the City and County of Riverside. We heard unit C236 (we later
9 identified as partner Officers Weddle and Macias) broadcast “shots fired.” Officer Serrato and I heard an
10 unknown unit broadcast that the suspect was armed with a shotgun and rifle and a perimeter was needed
11 in the area of Prospect Street and Grove Avenue. I activated my unit’s overhead lights and sirens and
12 drove to C236’s location.

14 Officer Serrato and I reached the intersection of Pleasant Street and Grove Avenue and saw Officer
15 Romero pointing towards a house on the south side of Pleasant Street west of our location. We went to
16 Officer Romero who stated he last saw the suspect running through the backyards of the homes in an
17 easterly direction. Partner Officers Camp and Pap arrived on scene seconds later. Officers Serrato, Camp,
18 Pap and I went to the south west corner of Pleasant and Grove to establish a perimeter. There were several
19 dark areas and bushes around us which could be used as a hiding spot so we systematically checked the
20 possible hiding spots in teams of twos.

22 Just as we completed our checks of the area, I heard a muffled bang. Officers Serrato, Camp, Pap and I
23 looked at each other and asked if we heard the sound. We all heard the sound and agreed it originated just
24 east of us. We started to move east on Pleasant Street towards the direction of the muffled bang. A few
25 seconds later, we saw a group of people run out of a house on the south side of Pleasant Street east of
26 Grove Avenue (later determined to be 2786 Pleasant). Several subjects ran towards us and yelled, “A guy
27 with a gun ran in our house!”

29 Officers Serrato, Camp, Pap and I ran to 2786 Pleasant and told everyone to exit the house. There were
30 two hysterical females in the front yard repeatedly yelling, “My grandpa’s in there.” I believed there was
31 an immediate threat to the life of the home’s occupant and general public based on the fact that three
32 Police Officers were shot at minutes earlier, an armed suspect was said to have forced his way into an
33 occupied house, and at least one victim was believed to still be inside the house with the suspect.

35 Officers Serrato, Camp, Pap and I formed a search team to enter 2786 Pleasant Street to save any potential
36 victims and subdue the suspect. When we entered the front door we noticed the house split in two
37 directions. Officer Camp held cover on the path to the right while Officer Serrato, Pap and I
38 systematically cleared the left side of the house. When we reached the hallway, there was a strong odor of
39 what I believed was gun smoke and the air was cloudy. We eventually reached the last room (farthest
40 south) of the house and saw a male lying on the floor. The male was lying face up with his feet closest to
41 the door and head closest to the south wall. The male had an apparent gunshot wound to the head and
42 there was a shotgun lying on the floor to the left of his body. I did not see the male’s chest rise or fall or
43 any other signs of life. Officer Pap maintained cover on the male and the shotgun while I helped complete
44 the safety sweep of the house. I later escorted two firefighters and a Fire Captain into the house so they
45 could check the downed male’s vitals (see initial report for further information).

- 1 After the house was cleared, Sergeant Perkins assigned Officer Serrato and I to shut down northbound
- 2 traffic on Grove Avenue at Prospect Street. We were later reassigned by Sergeant Stump to maintain
- 3 scene security inside 2786 Pleasant Street while patrol officers canvassed the area for witnesses and
- 4 evidence. Officer Serrato and I were relieved by Officer Rivera on 02/24/15 at approximately 0015 hours.
