On 02-23-15 at 2141 hours, I had just cleared a 459a PC radio call at 4211 Latham St., when I heard "shots fired" broadcast over the radio. Dispatch advised that Officers were on scene at 2851 Prospect St. reference a suspicious circumstances radio call.

Narrative:

I put myself en route via the MDC. While en route, Officer ROMERO broadcast that the suspect was last seen running through a residence onto Pleasant St.

I arrived on Park Ave./Pleasant St. and parked my unit in the street to block vehicular traffic from going eastbound on Pleasant St. I met up with Officers ROMERO, ELLIOT and SIVULA to the front of 2878 Pleasant St. We held our position there as a perimeter was being set up.

I maintained containment to the front of 2878 Pleasant St. and later canvassed the front and back yards with Officer SIVULA for evidence as S1 had run through this yard. I did not locate any evidence.

I maintained scene security on Pleasant St./Park Ave.

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At 2300 hours, Sergeant STUMP requested that I canvass for possible witnesses on Pleasant St. I took the north side of the street and Officer SIVULA took the south side of the street.

I made contact at 2865 Pleasant St. and spoke to O1, who was not cooperative. He said he was inside and heard the alarm to his Suburban go off. He walked to the front door and turned off the alarm, but said he didn't see anything.

I attempted contact at 2851 Pleasant St., but the front gate was locked. I tried getting the residents' attention by flashing my light through the windows, but no one came out.

I made contact at 2837 Pleasant St. and spoke to O2 in Spanish. He said that he and his family had been home sleeping, but did not hear or see anything. He said he later saw a police car drive by. He said that he has a camera on his front porch that faces the street and said we (police) can view the recording whenever we want.

I attempted contact at 2823 Pleasant St., but there was no answer at the front door. It did not appear that anyone was home.

I made contact at 2809 Pleasant St. and spoke to O3 in Spanish. He said that he and his wife (Isabel Esteban) had been out and returned home after the scene was already taped off. He said that Officers escorted them to their residence.

I made contact at [REDACTED] and spoke to O4 in Spanish. She said that she was home with her husband (Guillermo Garcia) and her mother (Christina Escobedo). She said that her husband and mother had been asleep. She said she heard (3) shots coming from down the street. About (20) minutes later, she heard (3-4) shots coming from down the street. About (1-2) minutes later, she heard another (3-4) shots coming from down the street. She said there are always shots being fired in the area, so she never bothered to look outside. She said there are several "Blacks" across the street east of Grove Ave. that are always causing problems.

All interviews were audio recorded using my department issued PUMA digital recorder.

Sergeant STUMP then instructed Officer ELLIOT, SIVULA and me to canvass the street (Pleasant St.) eastbound for any possible evidence. I did not locate any type of evidence.

I maintained scene security on Pleasant St./Park Ave. until 0030 hours, when I was relieved by Officer AGUIRRE.

At 0038 hours, I was cleared from the scene by Sergeant STUMP.
