

Notification: (Contacted and advised of the incident by Sergeant T. Banks)

On 02/23/15 at approximately 2245 hours, I arrived on the scene at the intersection of Park and Pleasant Street in the city of Riverside to assist with an officer involved shooting investigation that occurred near that location. After briefing the incident details with first responders and assisting Robbery/Homicide detectives, I was assigned to interview family members of suspect Steven Lewis at his home at 2865 Prospect. During the initial briefing I was advised that the family members had already been contacted and were still in the presence of patrol officers at 2865 Prospect. They were being very uncooperative and extremely unfriendly towards police. Detective Brandt and I walked over and introduced ourselves to the group of family members who were standing near the driveway of the home. I asked to speak with Isabel Lewis (wife) separately. She walked to the other side of the street with Detective Brandt and I but her son Andrew Lewis also walked with us. Lewis appeared to have an extremely hostile attitude towards all police officers in general.

Interview and Permission to search obtained from Isabel Lewis: (Audio recorded)

The first thing I explained to Isabel was that we had information that a shooting occurred in her back yard. She acted confused and said she didn't know anything about there being a shooting because she was in the house at the time. I told her that the police responded to her house because of an argument being heard along with possible gunshots. Isabel said she saw the police at her house but she didn't know why they were there. I asked if she argued with her husband in the back yard earlier and she denied that there was an argument between anyone. She said her entire family was in the house listening to music. Isabel said that the music was very loud and she never heard any arguments or gunshots. The guarded and evasive manner in which she spoke to us made me realize that no matter what questions I asked her, she was not going to be honest about the events that occurred prior to the incident.

I told Isabel that her back yard was now a crime scene and we had to process it for evidence. I explained that one of the other detectives was currently in the process of writing a search warrant allowing us to enter her property and process her home. It was an extremely cold night and I explained that if she would consent to the search as opposed to waiting for the warrant to be signed by a judge, the entire process would be faster. Detective Brandt provided Isabel with a consent to search form. After a brief discussion about her option to wait for the judge to sign the warrant she elected to give us her permission to process the rear yard for evidence. She signed the Permission to Search form and it is attached with this report.

Interview with Andrew Lewis:

Andrew's personality was extremely hostile and he made it clear that he did not like "The police." He also denied any knowledge of there being any weapons at the house or hearing gunshots. Andrew denied there were any arguments between his father, mother, or any other family member. He denied that his father was ever even in the back yard when the police went back there earlier. He said that other people always go in their yard because it faces the alley. Andrew said the police went into the yard and forcefully knocked on the door of the shed he sleeps in. He said they pointed guns at him and searched his room illegally. I tried to ask Andrew why the police even responded to his house but he was clearly angry and evasive. Again after a couple of my attempts to obtain information I knew that Andrew was not going to be cooperative.

Felicia Lewis:

In summary Felicia said she did not see or hear anything related to either before or after the incident.

Nicole Lewis:

Nicole was not home at the time of the incident. She and her boyfriend arrived at the house well after the police were already on scene.



Disposition:

Andrew and Felicia asked if they could get some warmer clothing from the house since they were choosing to wait outside while the house was being processed. I walked each of them inside separately and allowed them to get what they needed. Detective Brandt and I then searched the rear alley and walked the general neighborhood for possible evidence before returning to assist crime scene personnel.
