**Details**

On 3/2/15 I met with Officer Weddle at the Magnolia Station regarding this investigation. He was accompanied by his attorney, Saku Ethir. I had asked Officer Weddle if he would examine an aerial photograph of the crime scene and document where he was when the events occurred. He agreed. The interview was digitally recorded and later downloaded to the department server.

I showed Officer Weddle an aerial photograph of 2865 Prospect Ave. The photograph was taken on 2/24/15 which was the day after the incident. The photograph was taken by Evidence Technician Velin from a police helicopter. I asked Officer Weddle if he would use a red pen to document the suspects actions and a blue pen to document his actions.

Officer Weddle wrote an "A" in red ink where he saw the barrel of the shotgun come out of the shed. He then wrote an "A" in blue ink where he was when he fired into the shed in response to seeing the barrel of the shotgun.

Officer Weddle wrote a "1", "2" and "3" in the red ink where he heard the three shotgun blasts. He marked the numbers inside a red circle at the northwest corner of the property in the alley. He said that is where he heard the shotgun blasts come from.

Officer Weddle wrote a "1", "2" and "3" in blue ink where he was when he heard each shotgun blast. He wrote a "1" in the middle of the back yard. He said that is where he was when he heard the first shotgun blast. He wrote a "2" in the same area. He said that is where he was when he turned to run back to the shed and felt the shotgun debris hit his face. He wrote a "3" in the area of the shed. He said that is where he was when heard the third shotgun blast.
