**Narrative:**

On 02-23-15, at approximately 2150 hours, I received a phone call from Detective G. Rowe advising me of an Officer Involved Shooting that just occurred. I contacted Sergeant T. Banks, who advised he was initiating a call out, and asked me respond to the command post, which was established at Park Avenue and Pleasant Street, Riverside. I arrived at the scene at approximately 2250 hours.

While at the scene, I attended a briefing of the incident provided by Sergeant A. Perkins. Following the briefing Detective M. Medici and I were assigned to contact the residents at 2865 Prospect Avenue, which is where the initial call for service and shooting occurred. Detective Medici contacted the residents and recorded the conversations. I was present during the conversations and also witnessed the signed Permission to Search Form. Refer to Detective Medici's Supplemental Report for details of the conversation and a copy of the Permission to Search Form.

Upon completion of the interviews, and after receiving Permission to Search, I assisted Detective M. Medici, Detective D. Smith, Detective A. Tillett, and Senior Forensic Technicians T. Ellis and S. McKay-Davis with a search for evidence. The search also included the alley that runs east / west behind (north) 2865 Prospect Avenue, the property around 2878 Pleasant Street, and Pleasant Street from Park Avenue east to the residence located at 2786 Pleasant Street.

While at 2865 Prospect Avenue, I assisted Senior Forensic Technician T. Ellis with measurements for the scene sketch. This scene and evidence located / collected will be documented in Supplemental Reports prepared by Detective A. Tillett and Senior Forensic Technician S. McKay-Davis.

Detective Medici and I walked Pleasant Street, from Park Avenue, to 2786 Pleasant Street looking for any evidence or discarded contraband but did not find anything.

At approximately 0455 hours, I was present while Officer S. Lopez (#1011) removed Officer Romero's patrol rifle, which was secured in Romero's marked Riverside Police Department vehicle (unit #3507). Officer S. Lopez assisted Senior Forensic Technician L. Velin with charting the rifle. Officer S. Lopez removed the magazine from the weapon and rendered the weapon safe. There was no round chambered in the weapon and the magazine, which is a thirty (30) round magazine, contained twenty-nine (29) rounds. Refer to Senior Forensic Technician L. Velin's Supplemental Report and photographs for details.

Officer S. Lopez reloaded the magazine with the twenty-nine (29) rounds and re-secured the weapon in Unit #3507.

I cleared the scene at approximately 0530 hours.
