8 **EVIDENCE:**

9 The evidence was collected by Senior Forensic Technician McKay-Davis (see her
10 supplemental report for complete details on all the evidence collected and photographs taken
11 during the crime scene processing). Senior Forensic Technician Ellis obtained the measurements
12 and created the crime scene sketch (see his supplemental report for further details).

13
14 **BACKGROUND & SOURCE:**

15 I am a Detective with the Riverside Police Department assigned to the Centralized
16 Investigations Bureau Persons Unit (Robbery/Homicide). On 02-23-15 at 2250 hours, I received a
17 phone call from Sergeant McCoy requesting that I respond to the command post in the area of
18 Park Ave. and Pleasant St., in the city and county of Riverside, to assist with the investigation of an
19 Officer Involved Shooting (OIS). I arrived at the command post at 2330 hours.

20
21 After the initial brief, Detective Smith and I were assigned to process two of the three crime
22 scenes. One of the crime scenes was the rear yard of 2865 Prospect Ave. The second crime
23 scene was the alley adjacent to the north side of the rear yard of 2865 Prospect Ave. The alley ran
24 east and west and was bordered by Park Ave. to the west and Grove Ave. to the east. Detectives
25 Medici and Brandt, and Senior Evidence Technicians Ellis and McKay Davis also assisted with
26 processing the scene.

1 **INVESTIGATION:**

2
3 **Scene Description**

4 The OIS occurred in the rear yard of 2865 Prospect Ave. and the alley just north of the rear
5 yard. The following is a description of the scene:
6

7 **2865 Prospect Ave.**

8 2865 Prospect Ave. is a single story residence located on the north side of Prospect Ave., the
9 third house east of Park Ave. The rear yard of the residence backs up to an alley that runs east
10 and west between Park Ave. and Grove Ave. There were two structures on the property located
11 just north of the main residence. One was a storage shed that was situated along the west
12 perimeter fence. There was also an "E-Z UP" set up between the storage shed and the main
13 residence. The door to the shed faced east. Just east of the shed and north of the main residence
14 was another shed type structure that appeared to have been converted to provide a living space.
15 The door to the structure faced west towards the storage shed.
16

17 There was a dog run area located in the northeast corner. A "batting cage" net was set up
18 along the west perimeter fence just north of the storage shed, and ran almost to the end of the
19 property along the alley. The fence that bordered the rear alley was chain link approximately four
20 feet high. A taller wooden fence ran along the west side of the rear yard. The east fence was a
21 combination of chain link from the midpoint of the yard north to the alley, and a wood fence from
22 the midpoint south towards Prospect Ave. On the next page is a photo of the location taken from
23 Google Maps. The map is consistent with how the location looked on the day of the incident.



The north alley was located adjacent to the north side of the rear yard of 2865 Prospect Ave. The alley ran east and west and was bordered by Park Ave. to the west and Grove Ave. to the east. See below photo of the location taken from Google Maps. The map is consistent with how the location looked on the day of the incident.

1 **Scene Processing / Evidence Collected**

2
3 **Rear yard of 2865 Prospect Ave.**

4 Detective Medici, Detective Brandt, Detective Smith, Senior Forensic Technician Ellis, Senior
5 Forensic Technician McKay-Davis, and I began processing the scene, locating, photographing,
6 measuring and collecting evidence. Senior Forensic Technician McKay-Davis started by taking
7 video and overall photographs of both locations.

8
9 We located a spent Winchester .40 caliber shell casing (TM01) on the ground just west of the
10 backdoor steps and walkway. There were two additional Winchester .40 caliber shell casings
11 (TM02-TM03) on the ground just east of the backdoor steps and walkway, in front of the water
12 heater. There was a black Beretta semi-automatic handgun, unloaded with no magazine (TM04)
13 inside the storage shed on top of a tool bag. On the ground just north of the storage shed were
14 two Winchester 12 gauge 00 Buck live shotgun rounds (TM05-TM06).

15
16 There was a bullet hole in the northeast corner post of the "E-Z UP" (photo A). There were
17 three bullet strikes on the southeast corner of the storage shed (photos B-D), and three additional
18 bullet holes along the east side of the storage shed (photos E-G). All the bullet strikes/holes were
19 consistent with a south to north trajectory.

20
21 There was an upside down orange five gallon bucket on the ground, just to the south of the
22 door to the converted shed, with a broken glass jar just to the south of it. There were two small
23 holes on the north side of the bucket and two small holes on the south side of the bucket that were
24 consistent with a "BB" or .22 caliber sized round (photos H-K), however the holes did not line up to
25 indicate an entrance/exit point. We also noted a small hole in the stucco of the north wall of the
26 main residence just east of the water heater (photo L). At that time the holes did not appear to be
27 related to the incident.

28
29 We located six bullet strikes on the inside of the east perimeter wood fence (photos M-R) that
30 were consistent with a north to south trajectory. We also noticed that there was a hole in the

1 kitchen window on the north side of the neighboring residence located to the east of 2865 Prospect
2 Ave. (2851 Prospect Ave.). The hole was in line with the bullet strikes on the east perimeter wood
3 fence.

4
5 **The north alley**

6 We located several items of evidence, in close proximity to each other, on the ground in the
7 alley northwest of the northwest corner of the rear yard of 2865 Prospect Ave. There was soil with
8 possible blood (TM07), a tied bandana with a skull pattern (TM08), a Winchester 12 gauge Super
9 X live shotgun round (TM09), and two Winchester 12 gauge 00 Buck expended shotgun shells
10 (TM10-TM11).

11
12 We located additional items of evidence further west down the alley at the south rear gate of
13 2878 Pleasant St. There was possible blood on top of the chain link fence (TM12), and a
14 Winchester 12 gauge 00 Buck expended shotgun shell (TM13) lying on the ground just south of
15 the fence.

16
17 We located additional items of evidence at the west entrance into the alley off of Park Ave.
18 Patrol unit #3507 was parked along the east curb of Park Ave. facing northbound. There was a
19 light/utility pole just east of the patrol unit. On the eastside of the pole was a metal access box.
20 There was a wood fence at the southwest corner of the alley, which was the rear yard fence of
21 2893 Prospect Ave.

22
23 There was a bullet strike (photo S) on the wood fence that was consistent with an east to west
24 trajectory. There were two bullet strikes (photos T and U) on the metal access box of the
25 light/utility pole. On the east sidewalk of Park Ave. just below the metal access box were three
26 heavily damaged lead projectiles (TM14-TM16).

27
28 **2851 Prospect Ave.**

29 We went over to 2851 Prospect Ave. after learning that the residence was struck by gun fire
30 (Note: I will be describing the damage to the kitchen window as if looking towards it while standing

1 in the rear yard of 2851 Prospect Ave.). There was a bullet strike (photo W) in the lower left frame
2 of the window screen with a lead projectile lodged in it (TM18). There was a through and through
3 bullet hole in the upper left corner of the kitchen window (photo X). A lead projectile (TM17) was
4 lodged in the upper left frame of the kitchen doorway frame in line with the hole in the window.
5 There was a third bullet hole in the lower center-right area of the window (photo V). The bullet only
6 penetrated the outer window pane. The lead projectile (TM19) was recovered from between the
7 two panes.
