Narrative:

On 02-23-2015 at about 2230 hours I was contacted by Sergeant Troy Banks over the phone. Sergeant Banks informed me of an Officer Involved Shooting Investigation that occurred at 2865 Prospect Avenue, Riverside. Sergeant Banks requested that I respond to assist with the investigation.

Upon arrival to the scene, I met with Detective Rick Cobb of the Riverside Police Department Robbery-Homicide Unit. Detective Cobb was assigned as the case agent of the investigation. While at the scene, we were briefed of the circumstances by Sergeant Aaron Perkins. Detective Cobb requested that I respond to the Magnolia Street Police Station to assist with the charting of the involved Officer's firearms.

On 02-24-2015 at about 0245 hours, Evidence Tech Velin and I met with Officer Spencer Weddle in the Evidence Unit Office at the Magnolia Street Police Station. Evidence Tech Velin took photographs of Officer Weddle. We then proceeded to photograph and chart Officer Weddle's firearm that was involved in this investigation.

Officer Spencer Weddle #1718:

Duty firearm: Glock Model 22

Caliber: .40 Caliber

Magazines: Total of (3) each with a 15 round capacity

Inventory: (1) Magazine with (14) live rounds were loaded inside of Officer Weddle's duty firearm. (1) live round was in the chamber of the handgun.

(2) additional magazines at full capacity of (15) each were located on Officer Weddle's duty belt. These magazines and live rounds were photographed and retained as evidence.

Results: Officer Weddle's duty firearm was missing (1) round.

Back up firearm: None

Officer Edwin Romero #1720:

Duty firearm: Glock Model 22

Magazines: Total of (3) each with a (15) round capacity

Inventory: (1) Magazine with (15) live rounds were loaded inside of Officer Romero's duty firearm. (1) live round was in the chamber of the handgun.

(2) additional magazines at full capacity of (15) each were located on Officer Romero's duty belt. These magazines and live rounds were photographed.

Officer Romero had one live .223 / 5.56 round in his pants pocket. Officer Romero said he deployed his patrol rifle during the incident, chambering a live round from his magazine into the chamber of the rifle. Officer Romero said after the incident he removed the live round from the chamber of his patrol rifle and placed it in his pants pocket. The live round was photographed and retained by Officer Romero. Officer Romero's patrol rifle was later charted at the scene of the incident.

Results: No rounds were missing from Officer Romero's firearm.

Back up firearm: None

Issued firearm: Officer Romero was not issued a replacement firearm.
