4 **Evidence:**

- 5 1. Clothing (black short sleeved shirt, blue jeans, blue belt, green underwear, gray/ blue
- 6 tennis shoes, gray/ black socks)
- 7 2. Paper bags covering both hands
- 8 3. Blood sample from S/Lewis
- 9 4. Plastic wadding cup (from below left eye, inside S/Lewis' head)
- 10 5. Multiple small lead pellets (from inside S/Lewis' head, scalp and skull)

12 ***All evidence items were collected by Riverside Sheriff Department personnel and retained at
13 their office until they were collected by RPD personnel on February 26th and then booked into
14 evidence.***

16 **Investigation:**

17 On February 24, 2015 I attended the autopsy of S/Steven Lewis which took place at the
18 Riverside County Sheriff/ Coroner's Office. The autopsy was performed by Dr. Hunt and her
19 assistants. The procedure began at 1245 hrs with the breaking of the body bag seal. The
20 procedure ended at 1457 hrs.

21 Dr. Hunt began by conducting an exterior examination of the S/Lewis' body. S/Lewis' clothing
22 was still on him when the bag was opened. One shoe was on a foot, the other was inside the
23 body bag. His pants and underwear were partially pulled down from his waist and there
24 appeared to be mud on the pant legs. RSD personnel took photos of each clothing item before
25 packaging them.

28 I observed that S/Lewis had some visible tattoos on his arms. On his right arm I saw a picture of
29 hearts and roses; on his left arm I saw a cross tattoo.

30
31 There were three primary areas of obvious trauma on S/Lewis' body. The first was his head,
32 face and neck areas. There was severe trauma to his face that appeared to be from a contact
33 shotgun wound under his chin. His face was torn apart in to several flaps of skin and tissue.
34 Dr. Hunt used some clamps to reconstruct S/Lewis' face for photos. S/Lewis' left eye was
35 protruding significantly from the eye socket.

36
37 There was a hole, the size of a shotgun muzzle, under S/Lewis' chin. This hole was discolored
38 and had soot marks around it. This appears to be the point of entry for the shotgun round that
39 entered S/Lewis' head and caused the trauma to his face.

41 The second area of trauma was in S/Lewis' lower left abdominal area. This wound appeared to
42 be a smaller bullet hole with no visible soot around it.

44 The third area of trauma was in S/Lewis' right butt cheek. This wound also appeared to be a
45 smaller bullet hole with no visible soot around it.

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1 Dr. Hunt next conducted an internal examination of S/Lewis. Dr. Hunt was able to conclude that
2 the bullet hole in the abdominal area was an entrance wound and the hole in the butt cheek was
3 the exit wound from the same bullet. The path of travel for this bullet did not strike any vital
4 organs. She was also able to locate the multiple shotgun pellets and shotgun wadding within
5 S/Lewis' head, skull and scalp. All of these items were collected and packaged.

7 Once the autopsy was finished, I cleared at about 1500 hrs.
