13 **Narrative:**

14 On Tuesday, November 18, 2014, at about 1345 hrs, the above listed personnel and I
15 descended to the area of 5433 Bushnell Ave. to assist Det. Detmer in reference a possible
16 narcotics dealer in possession of methamphetamine and a handgun (See Det. Detmer's
17 supplemental for further details). Upon arriving in the area Det. Detmer advised the suspect's
18 vehicle was not at the residence. Det. Detmer instructed me and other surveillance personnel
19 to stay in the outskirts of the streets leading to the residence to see if the suspect vehicle could
20 be located on its way back to the residence. I took a position of surveillance southeast of the
21 residence. I parked my vehicle on Keller Ave. east of Jones Ave. looking westbound towards
22 the intersection of Bushnell Ave. and Keller Ave.
23

24 At about 1430 hrs I saw a gray Nissan Frontier pick-up driving northbound on Jones Ave.
25 towards Keller Ave. I broadcasted the description of the pick-up and began to drive towards
26 Jones Ave. in an attempt to confirm the license plate. Unbeknownst to me the primary
27 takedown vehicle (Ofc. Ortiz and Ofc. Adcox) was east of me on Keller Ave. I saw them behind
28 me so I pulled to the right and allowed them to pass me up and drive towards the truck. The
29 pickup truck continued north on Jones Ave. as it passed Keller Ave. The takedown unit got
30 behind the truck and confirmed the license plate over the air and advised it was indeed the
31 suspect vehicle we were looking for. Ofc. Adcox then advised he was going to go to channel 1
32 to put out the stop with dispatch. I followed at a distance behind and watched as the truck failed
33 to yield to the lights and siren at a slow speed. The truck turned west on Campbell Ave. then
34 gained some speed as he turned south on Bushnell Ave. I advised surveillance units to
35 converge on the suspect's residence as it appeared he was going in that direction. The suspect
36 drove into his driveway followed closely behind by the primary takedown and the secondary
37 takedown. As I got to the driveway I saw a subject later identified as S/Martinez running
38 southbound. I continued southbound Bushnell Ave. and turned east on Keller Ave. in an
39 attempt to intercept the suspect in the direction he was running.
40

41 I stopped to the front of 10479 Keller Ave. and got out of my vehicle. Almost immediately after I
42 exited my vehicle, I heard 5-6 gunshots coming from behind the residence I was standing in
43 front of. There were two males in the driveway of 10489 Keller Ave. Upon hearing the
44 gunshots they fell to the floor. I told them to go back inside their residence and lock the doors. I
45 maintained my containment position until Officers in the back yard of 10479 Keller Ave. advised
46 all Officers were "code 4" and the suspect was in custody.
47

48 Sgt. M. Cobb was the first supervisor to arrive. I advised him what the crime scene consisted of
49 and asked him to establish a perimeter and initiate crime scene logs.

1 I then knocked on the window of 10479 Keller Ave. to see if there was anyone home. A subject
2 who identified herself as O/Cynthia opened the window and briefly spoke to me. O/Cynthia
3 advised she was in the kitchen area of the residence with [REDACTED]
4 [REDACTED] when they heard 4-5 what she believed to be gun shots. O/Cynthia said they all hid
5 underneath the kitchen table. O/Cynthia did not see anything and they were not injured.
6

7 I later re-interviewed O/Cynthia in depth. This interview was audio recorded and downloaded
8 into the department's server. The following is a synopsis of her interview (listen to the audio
9 recording for further details):
10

11 O/Cynthia lives at 10479 Keller Ave. with her mother (Maribel), father (Angel Sr.), brother
12 (O/Henry), husband (Leopoldo Ambriz [REDACTED]) her aunt (Antonia), and
13 her uncle (Octavio). Today is O/Cynthia's husband's birthday and she has been preparing to
14 celebrate it. O/Cynthia had just walked inside the house from retrieving balloons from within the
15 rear detached garage when she heard what at first she believed were 4-5 shots from a "BB
16 gun". O/Cynthia then looked through the front window and saw me exit my vehicle. Upon
17 seeing my vest bearing "Police", O/Cynthia knew they were not shots from a BB gun. This
18 scared O/Cynthia which caused her to go around closing the opened windows. As she closed
19 the rear windows she saw other officers in the rear of the property. O/Cynthia said she did not
20 see anything else.
21

22 During the time of the incident, O/Cynthia, O/Henry, and [REDACTED] were the only ones home.
23 O/Cynthia had nothing further to add.
24

25 At about 1800 hrs, the Narcotics unit was instructed to conduct a search of S/Martinez's
26 residence (5433 Bushnell Ave.) and the residence to the front (5431 Bushnell Ave.). See Det.
27 Detmer's report for further details.
28

29 We cleared both residences prior to their search. I took overall photographs before the search
30 of 5433 Bushnell Ave., of the items recovered and after photographs. The photographs were
31 later downloaded into the department's DIMS system. NFI.
