12 **Scene Description:**

13 The initial residence is located at 5433 Bushnell Ave., Riverside. The residence is one of two residences
14 on the same property. The residence in question is located to the rear of the property facing westbound
15 towards the street. A long driveway leads up to the residence from the street, past the north side of the
16 first residence. The house is a single story residence.

17
18 The location of where the officer involved shooting occurred is located to the rear of 10479 Keller Ave.,
19 Riverside.

20
21 **Background:**

22 I am currently assigned to the Post-Release Accountability Compliance Team (PACT), which consists of
23 Officers and Deputies from multiple agencies throughout Riverside County. One of our duties is to
24 conduct compliance checks of persons who are currently on Parole, Probation, Mandatory Supervision,
25 Supervised Release and Post Release Community Supervision (PRCS).

26
27 **Narrative:**

28 On 11-18-14 at approximately 1349 hours, I was notified by Detective Detmer reference a request for
29 assistance for the Narcotics unit.

30
31 Det. Detmer said that he had reliable information that S/Vicente Martinez, who lived at 5433 Bushnell
32 Ave., was selling narcotics and may be armed with a firearm. He said he was currently at his residence
33 and was supposed to leave soon in his Nissan truck. I called Sgt. Corbett and advised him of the
34 circumstances and that PACT was planning on conducting a traffic stop when S/Martinez left his
35 residence.

36
37 I assembled the PACT team at the gas pumps and I conducted an operation briefing with the information
38 provided by Detective Detmer. I showed a photograph of Martinez and advised he was driving a Gray
39 Nissan Frontier with four doors and a license plate of 70580R1/CA.

40
41 I assigned Ofc. Ortiz and Adcox to be the primary unit for a traffic stop on S/Martinez if he left his
42 residence. I assigned Ofc. Mercadefe and Arangure to be back up officers for the traffic stop. Cpl
43 Marquez, Inv. Petti and I were going to be roaming the area for possible back up as needed. Dep. Stanley
44 and P.O. Huynh were also roaming the area for possible back up if needed.

1 Undercover Narcotics units arrived at the residence and advised S/Martinez' vehicle was not at the
2 location. PACT units were assigned various location in and around the neighborhood to try and locate the
3 vehicle if it returned to the residence.

4
5 I staged my unit at 10346 Keller Ave. (La Granada Elementary School) which was about two blocks east
6 of the primary residence. Officer Adcox advised via radio that the vehicle had passed their surveillance
7 position at Jones Ave/Keller Ave and that they were going to conduct a traffic stop. Ofc. Adcox advised
8 over the radio that the suspect vehicle was failing to yield.

9
10 The officers advised the vehicle had pulled into the driveway at 5433 Bushnell Ave. Ofc. Adcox advised
11 they were in foot pursuit. While we were still in route to the final stop, Officer Arangure advised via radio
12 that shots had been fired. After a few moments, Officer Arangure advised the suspect was down and to
13 start medical aid for the suspect.

14
15 Upon arriving on scene I noticed all three vehicles involved (Two black PACT team cars and one gray
16 truck) in the driveway of 5433 Bushnell Ave. Both black PACT team cars had their emergency lights
17 activated. The gray truck was parked directly in front of their vehicles with the radio playing very loud.

18
19 I assigned arriving personnel positions to set up a perimeter and locked down the scene for preservation of
20 evidence. I located Ofc. Ortiz, who was the officer involved in the shooting. I asked Ofc. Ortiz if he was
21 Ok? Ofc. Ortiz said "Yes".

22
23 As the Acting Supervisor for PACT, I asked Ofc. Ortiz some public safety questions, which included how
24 many rounds he fired, and what direction he fired in. Ofc. Ortiz answered he thought 5-8 shots in a south
25 west direction and he showed me where he was standing when he shot.

26
27 I immediately assigned officers to check with the residents of 10479 Keller Ave and 10491 Keller Ave,
28 which is the residences located in the direction of the shots fired by Ofc. Ortiz. The residents reported
29 they were not injured.

30
31 Ofc. Ortiz was then transported to the Magnolia Station with an escort from on duty RPOA personnel.
32 Officers Mercadefe, Arangure and Adcox were identified as witness officers and later transported to
33 Magnolia St with on duty RPOA personnel.

34
35 I remained on scene and provided an initial briefing to the OIS investigation team. I then conducted a
36 walk-through of the scene with the investigations team and showed the initial stop, direction of the foot
37 pursuit and the scene of the OIS.
