62. Narrative of Supplemental Report
I am currently assigned as the supervisor for the West - Post Release Accountability and Compliance Team. The team is a multi-agency / multi-jurisdictional taskforce.

On 11/18/2014, at approximately 1350 hours, Detective C. Williams called and told me Detective Detmer with the Riverside Police Department Narcotics Unit requested the assistance of West - PACT. Det. Detmer had information a subject in a vehicle had narcotics and was possibly armed with a gun. Detective Williams told me the plan was to conduct a traffic stop if West - PACT located the suspect vehicle.

While I was at an appointment, Lieutenant Dinco heard on the radio that Officer Arangure had broadcast shots were fired at the West - PACT location. I immediately left the appointment and drove to the Officer Involved Shooting scene. I arrived at 10479 Keller Avenue and walked into the rear yard where the shooting occurred. Officer Ortiz had already been removed from the scene and was being transported to the Magnolia Police Station.

Officers Adcox, Arangure, Mercadefe, Deputy Stanley and Probation Officer Huynh from West – PACT along with Officer Hibbard and several Riverside Fire Department personnel were in the rear yard.

Since Officer Ortiz had already been removed from the scene, I asked Officer Adcox what his involvement was. He said he was very close to Officer Ortiz when the shooting occurred. I asked him how many rounds he thought were fired and in what direction. Officer Adcox estimated about 5-7 rounds and they were fired in a southwest direction. He also told me the residents in the house of 10479 Keller Avenue had been contacted and were okay.

I had Officer Mercadefe check the area in the direction the rounds were fired for any rounds that may have struck the house and /or vehicles. No strike marks were located. Once I verified the immediate scene was secure I began having involved witness officers transported to the Magnolia Police Station (Officers Arangure, Adcox and Mercadefe).

I walked to the area where the foot pursuit of the suspect began. I saw two PACT vehicles at the end of a long driveway (5433 Bushnell Ave.). Both vehicles had their emergency lights activated. The vehicles engines were off and the lights and radio were still on. I shut of the emergency lights in both vehicles and looked at the area where the foot pursuit took place.

I remained on scene until Detective C. Williams provided investigators the briefing of the incident. I cleared the scene following the briefing.
