1 **ASSIGNMENT:**

2 I am a Police Corporal for the Corona Police Department assigned to a multi-
3 agency task force called the Post Release Accountability and Compliance Team
4 – West (PACT). The primary function of this task force is to monitor and conduct
5 compliance check on subjects who have been released on Probation, Parole,
6 Mandatory Supervision, and Post Release Community Supervision.

7
8 The Task force is comprised of members from the Riverside Police Department,
9 Corona Police Department, Riverside County Sheriff's Department, Probation
10 Department, District Attorney Office and The Federal Bureau of Alcohol,
11 Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives.

13 This task force is housed at the Riverside Police Departments Magnolia Station,
14 10540 Magnolia Ave., Riverside.

28 **SCENE:**

29 The residence where the foot pursuit ended and the suspect was located is
30 10479 Keller Ave., Riverside.

31
32 The residence where the vehicle pursuit ended was 5433 Bushnell Ave. The
33 residence is one of two residences on the same property. A long driveway leads
34 up to the residence from the street, past the north side of the first residence.
35 The house is a single story residence.

37 **DETAILS:**

38 On 11-18-14 at approximately 1349 hours, Officers of the PACT team and I were
39 notified by Detective Williams reference a request for assistance from RPD's
40 Narcotics unit.

41
42 Williams advised the Narcotics unit was attempting to locate a male subject
43 identified as **(SU01) Vicente Martinez** and living at 5433 Bushnell Ave.,
44 Riverside. They further advised the subject was possibly carrying narcotics
45 along with a loaded firearm.

1 **Details: -Cont.-**

2 All listed PACT team personnel met for a briefing, prior to responding to the listed
3 address. During the briefing I was shown a photograph of Martinez and advised
4 he was driving a Gray Nissan Frontier with four doors and a license plate of
5 70580R1/CA. Also provided during the briefing were the assignments to be
6 handled by each officer involved. Detective Williams, District investigator Petti
7 and I were tasked with staying nearby the primary residence to provide backup
8 for the primary surveillance units as needed.

9

10 We responded to the area and parked at 10346 Keller Ave., La Granada
11 Elementary school, which was about two blocks away from the primary
12 residence. While parked, Officer Adcox advised the vehicle had passed their
13 surveillance position and that they were going to attempt a traffic stop. I then
14 heard over the radio that the suspect vehicle was failing to yield. We proceeded
15 to the directions being given by the primary officer.

16

17 The officers advised the vehicle had pulled into the driveway at 5433 Bushnell
18 Ave. The suspect proceeded to exit the vehicle and foot pursuit was initiated.
19 While we were still in route to the final stop Officer Arangure advised over the
20 radio that shots had been fired. After few moments Officer Arangure advised the
21 suspect was down and to start medical aid for the suspect.

22

23 Upon arriving on scene, I noticed all three vehicles involved (Two black PACT
24 cars and one Gray truck) in the driveway of 5433 Bushnell Ave. Both black
25 PACT cars had their emergency lights activated. The gray truck was parked
26 directly in front of their vehicles with the radio playing loud.

27

28 D.A. investigator Petti and I proceeded to clear the backyard for any possible
29 dangers with negative results.

30

31 At this time I requested for Deputy Stanley and PO Officer Huynh to relieve Officer
32 Ortiz from his current position due to being directly involved in the Officer
33 Involved Shooting. Officer Ortiz was relieved and subsequently transported to the
34 station.
