Background:

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20 I am a Police Officer with the Riverside County District Attorney's Office/Bureau of Investigation,
21 assigned to a multi-agency task force called the Post Release Accountability and Compliance Team-West
22 (PACT). One of our duties is to conduct compliance checks of persons who are currently on Parole,
23 Probation, Mandatory Supervision, Supervised Release and Post Release Community Supervision
24 (PRCS).

Narrative:

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28 On 11-18-14, about 1345 hours, The West Post Release Accountability and Compliance Team, was
29 contacted by The Riverside Police Department SIB Narcotics Team to assist in trying to locate and
30 contact Robert Martinez who was possibly in possession of a handgun and narcotics. Martinez is a
31 convicted felon. Martinez lived at 5433 Bushnell Ave., in the City of Riverside. Martinez was known to
32 be driving Nissan Frontier, gray in color, with a Ca. plate, 70580R1.

34 Det. Williams conducted a briefing in the Magnolia Station rear parking lot with PACT units and we were
35 all sent a photo of Vincente Martinez, as well as his address and vehicle description. Det. Williams
36 assigned PACT units to certain duties. Det. Williams, Cpl. Marquez, and myself all went in one unit and
37 were to provide a backup response to other PACT vehicles assigned to contact Martinez. We drove and
38 parked our vehicle in the La Granada School parking lot located at 10346 Keller Ave.

40 Riverside SIB Narcotics Team members had Martinez's residence on Bushnell under surveillance and
41 were informing PACT units of information regarding Martinez. They advised Martinez was possibly in
42 route to his residence from an unknown location and was supposed to be driving the Gray Nissan truck
43 mentioned above.

1 About 1430 hours, SIB Narcotic Team member on surveillance advised that they had a possible vehicle
2 matching Martinez's traveling N/bound Jones Ave. just south of Keller Ave. Ofc. Ortiz and Ofc. Adcox
3 advised they were behind the vehicle and confirmed the vehicle description and plate matched what
4 Martinez was supposed to be driving. An unknown SIB Narcotic Team member advised over the radio to
5 try and conduct a traffic stop on Martinez. A short time later, Ofc. Adcox advised they were going to try
6 and conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle and they were switching to primary radio channel. A few seconds
7 later were heard Ofc. Adcox on primary channel advising they were trying to conduct a traffic stop on the
8 vehicle and you could hear a siren in the background. Ofc. Adcox then advised they had a failure to yield.

10 Det. Williams, Cpl. Marquez and myself, as well as Deputy Stanley and Probation Officer Huynh, who
11 were staging at the school started to drive in the location and direction of are units. While we were
12 driving, Ofc. Arangure advised over the radio, "Shots fired". Ofc. Arangure advised a second time.
13 "Shots fired" on Bushnell Ave.

15 We immediately responded to that area and stopped in front of 5433 Bushnell Ave. I went to the backyard
16 and I found Ofc. Ortiz and Ofc. Adcox located in a rear yard at 10479 Keller Ave. Ofc. Ortiz advised they
17 were ok and Ofc. Mercadefe told me to watch the residence I was at. I stayed at the 3-4 corner of the
18 residence until I was relieved by a Riverside Police Department Patrol Officer about 1600 hours.
