23 Detective Rowe, DDA Cook, Senior DA Investigator Caballero, and I observed the autopsy from
24 the autopsy viewing room. Evidence Technician Velin was in the autopsy room. Martinez was on
25 exam table #39 in a sealed white body bag. The seal on Martinez's body bag was broken at 0907
26 hours.

28 **Clothing**

29 Martinez was wearing blue boxer shorts. There was a pair of tan work boots, pair of white
30 socks, black t-shirt, white tank top, and khaki pants with a black belt in the body bag with Martinez.

1 Dr. Park then conducted the internal examination. Fragments were recovered from the elbow
2 area, and a projectile was recovered from the forearm area, of the right arm. The gunshot wound
3 on the right chest was determined to be an exit wound. A projectile was recovered from the spine
4 (mid back). A projectile was recovered from the right neck area, and another projectile was
5 recovered from the left neck area.

7 **ITEMS COLLECTED:**

8 I observed the listed items being collected by Evidence Technician Velin (see her Supplemental
9 Report for complete details on all the evidence collected and photographs taken during the
10 autopsy):

- 11
- 12 - Martinez's clothing
- 13 - Leatherman tool
- 14 - Lighter
- 15 - clear plastic bag containing an amount of an off white crystalline substance.
- 16 - Projectiles and fragments recovered from Martinez's body

1 There was a leatherman tool in a pouch on the black belt. A lighter and a clear plastic bag,
2 containing an undetermined amount (at that time) of an off white crystalline substance (based on
3 my training and experienced believed to be methamphetamine), were found in the right front
4 pocket of the khaki pants. Martinez's hands were covered with paper bags which were removed.
5 He had a black watch on his left wrist. He also had a pair of handcuffs around his left wrist only.

7 **Tattoos**

8 When all of the clothing was removed from Martinez, I noted the following gang specific tattoos
9 based on my past training and experience as a former member of the Riverside Police Department
10 Gang Intelligence Unit:
11

12 Riverside Raincross/Mission Bell (center chest)

13 "I" (right shin) and an "E" (left shin)

14 La Sierra" (upper back)

15 "Brown Knights" with an image of a knight (lower back)

16 "L" (front of right shoulder) and an "S" (front of left shoulder)

17 A shield with an "L" and an "S" superimposed in the center (upper left arm)

18 Image of a Knight and a bullet (right side rib cage)

20 See photos taken by Evidence Technician Velin for the above listed tattoos and for the
21 additional tattoos that were noted.

23 **Injuries**

24 When all of the clothing was removed from Martinez, I noted the following injuries: a gunshot
25 wound to the right arm elbow area. There was a gunshot wound on the right chest near the right
26 arm/shoulder area. There were two gunshot wounds on the left side hip area in close proximity.

27 There was a gunshot wound on the left side under the left arm, and a gunshot wound in the upper
28 left back area (see photos for details).
