I heard a female voice inside say, "I'm coming to the door". A female opened the door and had a cordless phone in hand. I also saw a child standing in the bathtub peeking out from behind the shower curtain. Officer Mercadefe stayed with the them while I assisted in clearing the rest of the residence. I exited the residence and moved across the street to the front of 11531 Trailway Dr. I joined up with another team of officers who were covering on the house. A call was made into the house for the occupants to come out of the house one at a time. Five adults exited the residence and were taken to the driveway of the house to the west.

I approached the house first and made several announcements at the front door. I said, " Riverside Police, anyone inside the house come out to the front door with your hands in the air". I announced twice and waited for a response. There was no response and I entered the house with the team of officers and we cleared the house. Nothing of note was found inside upon our cursory clearing of the residence and no other people were inside.

After the search I was assigned to watch the house and preserve it as there might be evidence inside. I watched the house until I was relieved by Officers L. Skipper and P. Stucker. I exited the crime scene at approximately 2100 hours and was signed out of the crime scene on the crime scene log by Officer B. Merrill.
