**Narrative:**

On listed date and time, I was assigned to the Riverside Police Department's, Gang Intelligence Unit. At approximately 1800 hours, Detective Collopy and I were driving together when we monitored a radio call of shots being fired and coming from an address on Trailway Drive in the city and county of Riverside. We were several minutes away from the address and responded to assist patrol units that had been dispatched to the area.

Detective Collopy and I arrived on scene at approximately 1805 hours and we immediately began assisting Patrol Officers with the scene. I saw what appeared to be two victims laying on the grass and sidewalk in front of 11540 Trailway Drive. I looked across the street (from 11540 Trailway Dr) and saw another male subject lying face down on the sidewalk. I was unsure of outstanding suspects, so I began assisting by taking a perimeter spot in front of 11540 Trailway Dr. I saw more officers arrive and I saw patrol supervision arrive to direct officers in clearing several residences that appeared to be involved. During the time Patrol Officers were clearing houses, I stayed with the male and female victims and I began scene control by identifying evidence and keeping several neighbors away from the scene. I did not see or hear any response from the victims and they both appeared to have suffered multiple gunshots.

After the immediate scene was in control, several Emergency Medical Technicians came to my location, they checked for vital signs and then had to fall back to a safe area because new information came in and the scene needed to have additional areas checked. At approximately 1850 hours, I was directed by the Watch Commander to escort AMR personnel back to the victims so they could give a more detailed/official determination that the victims were in fact deceased.

At approximately 1900 hours, I met W/1 Nejedly who told me that he had witnessed the entire event and he had called 911 during the incident. I interviewed W/1 at the scene and I tape recorded the statement onto Det. Collopy's issued recorder. The following is a synopsis of the interview between me and W/1 Nejedly.

W/1 does not live in the neighborhood. W/1 is a Real Estate Broker, and he was in the area conducting business.

W/1 said he was about six houses away from the incident. W/1 saw a black male walking outside with another male subject. W.1 said he saw the suspect turn and he began firing at the other male subject, who then fell down on the grass. At that point, W/1 saw a female come running outside and the suspect began shooting at her from a distance of about 5 feet. W/1 said the female victim staggered around a truck (parked on the street) and then the suspect began firing more rounds as she was trying to crawl away underneath the truck. W/1 saw the suspect leaned underneath the truck and continue to fire 3 or 4 more rounds. The suspect walked around to the front of the truck, and that's when W/1 yelled at the suspect. W/1 said he yelled "give up the police are on their way". The suspect then yelled back at the witness that he was "defending himself." W/1 said he watched as the suspect turned back around, and while the victim was lying on the ground, he shot her twice more at "point blank range".

W/1 said the suspect began walking across the street (away from the victims) and that's when he saw police arrive. W/1 said he saw the suspect point his weapon at the direction of the police, and that's when he heard two more rounds. W/1 was not sure if the suspect fired at the police, but he remembers hearing two more shots and then he (the suspect) fell to the ground. W/1 did not see the police officers, but he saw police cars arriving in the street. W/1 said he heard over 20 shots during the entire incident. W/1 remembers the suspect yelling something at the female victim as she was lying on the ground. W/1 said the suspect said something like "take that" and things that made the witness believe it was a "crime of passion". W/1 described the suspect as a black male, 602, 220 lbs.
