Narrative:

On 05-10-2011, I was contacted by Detective Jim Brandt over the phone. Detective Brandt informed me that an officer involved shooting had occurred at 11532 Trailway Drive. I met with Detective Brandt at the Magnolia Street police station. Detective Brandt and I then responded to the command post on Trailway Drive. I arrived on-scene at about 1910 hours.

While at the command post we were given a briefing of the incident by Sergeant Denny Corbett. I was assigned to process the interior crime scene of the victims residence located at 11532 Trailway Drive. The above listed personnel attended the crime scene walk thru.

The crime scene was video recorded and digitally photographed by assisting I.D. techs.

Vehicles located at residence:

This vehicle was parked in the east portion of the driveway of the victim's residence.

This vehicle was parked in the west portion of the driveway of the victim's residence.

This vehicle was parked inside the garage near the east wall of the two car portion.

2006 BMW 650i, 2 door, dark blue in color, license # [REDACTED]

This vehicle was parked in the garage next to the above listed Chevy Cavalier.

Firearm located during search of victim's vehicle:

Smith and Wesson M&P .40 caliber semi-automatic handgun, black in color. Serial # DTW5506
This handgun was located in the trunk of the 2002 Chevy Cavalier.

Residence description:

The residence located at 11532 Trailway Drive is described as a single family, two story residence constructed with tan stucco and brown wood trim. The residence is located on the south side of Trailway Drive. The double front entry doors face north toward Trailway Drive. The residence has an attached 3 car garage. The two car exterior garage door is located on the east portion of the garage. The single car exterior garage door is located on the west portion of the garage. I noticed two vehicles parked in the driveway of the residence. One vehicle was a Kia Sorento and the other vehicle was a Mazda 3.

I accessed a public records realtor website on the internet which described the residence located at 11532 Trailway Drive. The residence was built in 2002, has 5 bedrooms and 4.5 baths. The residence is approximately 4,264 square feet.

Prior to processing the interior of the residence, Supervising I.D. tech Carlton Fuller used a digital camera to photograph the residence. Each item of evidence located within the residence was also photographed. Approximate measurements of the evidence were also obtained by Fuller and me prior to collection.

Interior Description:

The front door to the residence was open and unlocked. I noticed a large amount of blood drops leading out of the front door onto the porch. Blood drops were on the door and interior door handle. As you enter the front door the formal dining room is to the left (east).

The dining room floor consisted of carpet. The entryway flooring was ceramic tile. As you walk south past the dining room the carpeted stairway is on the right (west) which leads upstairs. Continuing south from the dining room is the family room and kitchen area. Both family room and kitchen consisted of ceramic tile flooring. The kitchen table is located between the family room and kitchen. The kitchen table had a large round carpet-rug on top of the ceramic tile and under the table. The kitchen is located to the left (east) and the family room is to the right (west). On the south wall between the kitchen and family room is the rear sliding glass door which leads to the backyard.

The sliding glass door had been broken out and was lying on the kitchen floor. The glass had glass tint on it which held most of the glass together in a large piece. A cell phone and empty handgun magazine was also on the floor next to the broken glass. A large blood trail which began from the backyard entered into the residence through the broken sliding glass door. A large blood trail continued down the main walkway, past the stairs leading to the second floor and out the front door to the front driveway. I also noticed a smaller blood trail which appeared to lead from the broken out sliding glass door, around the kitchen center island and through the small dining room entryway which is located on the east portion of the kitchen. Blood drops were also located on the kitchen counter tops. This blood trail continued along the formal dining room carpeted floor and out the front door.

The family room had a large flat screen television which was on upon entry. The family room light and kitchen lights were also on. The family room closet was located on the north wall of the family room. There was a large storage area inside this closet that went under the stairway that leads to the second floor. I noticed an empty black plastic holster on a shelf inside this closet. Next to the empty holster was the outer garment to a bullet proof vest. West of the family room is a hallway which leads to the south-west guest bedroom. North of the hallway is the guest bathroom in the north-west corner of the residence and the laundry room is to the right (east) of the bathroom. The interior garage door is located on the north wall of the hallway which leads into the main portion of the garage. The dark blue BMW and the silver Chevy Cavalier was parked inside the garage. Both vehicles were locked and secured. On the garage floor I saw storage boxes near the west wall. One of these plastic storage boxes had the name "Virgil Millon" written on it.

The carpeted stairway that leads to the second floor is accessed from two locations. A small stairway begins near the front door. A second small stairway leads from the family room. Both accesses meet on a small landing to the main stairway upstairs. The master bedroom is on the second floor and located on the south side of the second floor. The master bedroom bathroom and walk in closet is connected to the east side of the master bedroom.

The second floor hallway leads to the second floor south west bedroom, north-west bedroom, hallway bathroom and north-east bedroom. The north east bedroom was converted to a gym which contained a weight lifting bench, treadmill and other exercise equipment.

I conducted a search of the upstairs bedrooms and did not locate any items of evidence.

In the upstairs hallway linen shelf, first responding officers had located a handgun magazine and ammunition. This was photographed, measured and collected by I.D. tech Fuller.

I.D. tech Fuller and I located several bullet projectiles in the kitchen area. One projectile was found inside the kitchen pantry. It had passed through the pantry door. Another projectile had passed through the kitchen refrigerator door and was found inside the refrigerator. One projectile was found lying on top of the round carpet rug under the kitchen table.

We also located a bullet projectile under a chair that was located in the formal dining room. This projectile appeared to have struck the drywall of the kitchen, passed through a pillow that was near the formal dining room table, struck a chair against the north formal dining room wall, coming to rest under the chair.

A piece of copper jacketing from a projectile was also located on the carpeted floor of the south west bedroom. This projectile went through two windows located in the south west corner of the south west bedroom.

All bullet strikes and recovered projectiles were measured and photographed by I.D. tech Fuller and I prior to being collected as evidence. (See I.D. tech Fuller's supplemental report for detailed description and location)

I conducted a search of the first floor of the residence. I also conducted a search of the garage including the two vehicles which were parked inside the garage. Both vehicles were locked and secured. I obtained the keys to both vehicles from V-1 Bradford's purse which was in the kitchen. During the search of the Chevy Cavalier, I located a Smith and Wesson M&P .40 caliber semi-automatic handgun inside a black holster secured in the locked trunk. The holster was on a small women's belt which included additional handgun magazines, baton, O.C. spray and handcuffs. I.D. tech Fuller photographed the handgun prior to collecting it as evidence. The handgun had a live round in the chamber and 10 rounds in the magazine which was connected to the gun. The serial number to the handgun was DTW5506. A registration check revealed this handgun was registered to V-1 Arabella Bradford at 11532 Trailway Drive, Riverside. I did not locate any evidence inside the BMW. The registration printout to both vehicles and handgun is attached to this report.

After photographing, taking measurements and collecting the evidence I left the scene at about 0940 hours on 05-11-2011.

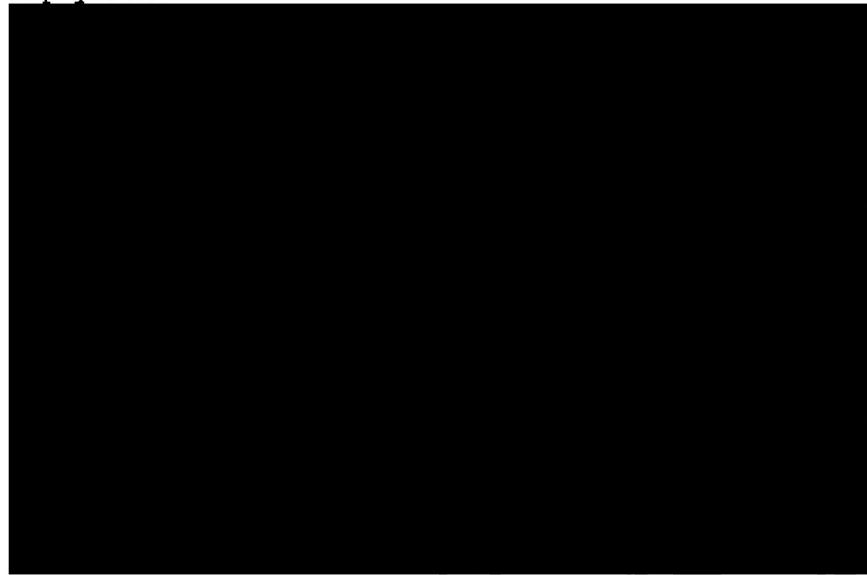

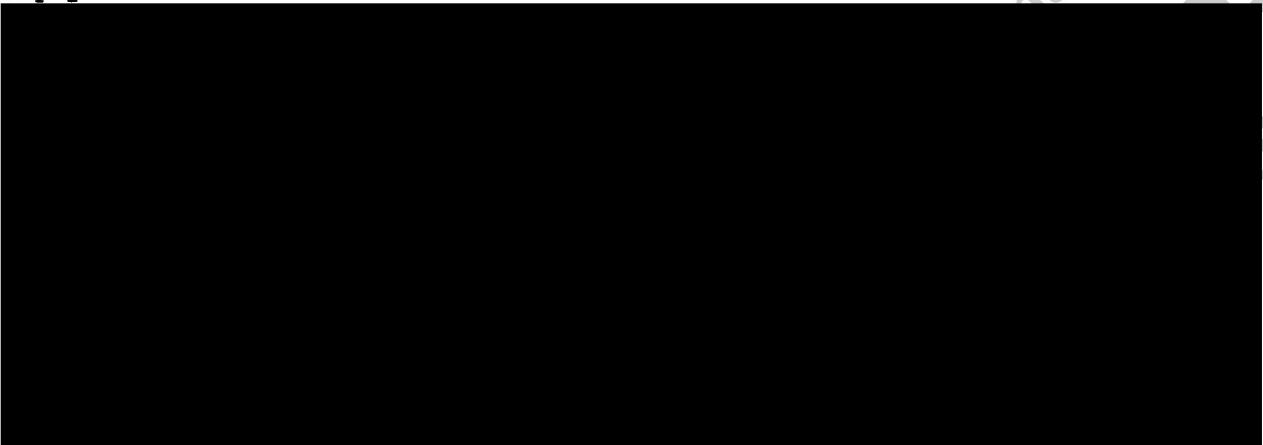
