Details

On 05-12-11, I attended the autopsy of V-Conley. The autopsy took place at the Riverside County Coroner's Office.

The autopsy began at 1304 hours. It was completed at 1520 hours. Dr. Young performed the autopsy.

V-Conley was fully clothed. He wore black sweat pants, grey shorts, blue boxer shorts, and a white t-shirt.

V-Conley was 69 inches tall and weighed 217 pounds at the time of autopsy.

Bullet wounds (Front)

1. Entry wound to right upper chest (Pierced Aorta)
2. Exit wound to mid chest (From back wound 5)

Bullet wounds (Back)

3. Entry wound to upper mid back (Entered spine)
4. Entry wound to upper rear of right arm
5. Entry wound to mid back

Three projectiles were found inside V-Conley. One from the left side of his chest, one from the right shoulder and one from the spine.

Evidence

Evidence from V-Conley was collected by Forensic Technician K. Wilson. I took custody of the evidence and later booked it into evidence at Magnolia Station. See attached property reports for evidence collected.
