SUMMARY/RESULTS

The Glock pistol functioned properly during examination and test firing.

EXAMINATION

The Glock pistol has a barrel with hexagonal rifling with a right twist. Its safeties and disconnecter are functioning. It has a trigger pull of 5¾ pounds. The magazine has a capacity of 15 cartridges. I test fired the pistol using 3 of the cartridges submitted with the magazine. The pistol functioned properly during examination and test firing.

DISPOSITION

The test-fires, Item WL01-TF, will be stored at the Laboratory for five years. All remaining items will be returned to the appropriate agency.
