I noted to other people in the car along with the suspect. While announcements were being made to the suspects remaining in the car, I assembled a team to clear the car and secure the suspect kneeling down over the passenger seat. Once the two other suspects were removed from the car, I made the decision to use K9 Officer Feimer and his dog to remove the remaining suspect from the passenger seat to make sure he was not intending to ambush approaching officers. The K9 was deployed, pulled the suspect from the car then the team moved up and cleared the car. See Officer Feimer's supplemental report for further details.

After the scene was rendered safe and medical personnel were given access, I instructed Officer Romero to set up crime scene tape. I then instructed Officers Weddle and Barnhill to set up crime scene logs at the North and South end of the crime scene.

After the scene was secured and all personnel taken care of, I was relieved by Sgt. Cash and resumed patrol supervision duties.
