I, along with other supervision, directed officers to secure the scene and check the area for witnesses. Police personnel who were no longer needed were removed from the scene. Officers established crime scene logs on the north end and south end of the scene. Any potential evidence was directed to me and left in place. The scene was held until Robbery/ Homicide investigation personnel arrived. I briefed the Detectives and Supervision and relinquished the scene to them. Patrol officers remained for scene security and to continue to maintain the scene logs. I left at approx. 0444 hours.
