On 11-22-13, at approximately 2327 hours, I responded to 3020 E. La Cadena reference a report of an Officer Involved Shooting. I responded to the scene from eastbound 1<sup>st</sup> to northbound E. La Cadena. The initial radio traffic advised the driver was still in the car and the suspect was possibly behind the car.

When I arrived on scene I saw the suspect vehicle in the lot of 3020 E. La Cadena, facing north. I saw three patrol cars parked on E. La Cadena, just west of the vehicle. There were Officers using the patrol cars for cover. There was a patrol car parked behind the suspect car, to the south and facing north. I could see Officers at this patrol car covering the suspect vehicle. I took a position at this patrol car with my Police Service Dog (PSD) "Sando". I took a position at this location in case the suspect fled from the car in the east direction I could deploy the PSD.

While I was in position to the south of the suspect vehicle, I could see a suspect by the front passenger door. The suspect was on his knees and leaning into the car. I could only see from the waist down and I could not see the hands. I did not know if the suspect was still armed with a gun. I maintained this position of cover while a felony car stop was conducted. A male subject exited from the front driver position and was taken into custody. A female subject exited from the rear driver side door and was taken into custody.

An announcement was made over the Patrol Car PA system. The announcement advised anyone in the car to show themselves or a Police Dog would be used. The announcement was made by another Officer. I was advised by Sgt Wilson that the suspect had fired a gun at the initial Officer. I knew the suspect was armed with a gun and had just shot at Police. The suspect was not responding to commands. I did not know if the suspect was injured or pretending in order to draw Officers in to him for another attack. It would be extremely dangerous for Officers to leave a position of cover and approach an armed suspect. It was determined to use PSD "Sando" to apprehend the suspect and pull him away from the vehicle to where I could see his hands.

PSD "Sando" was sent to apprehend the suspect. PSD "Sando" initially bit the suspect in the left leg and started to pull him backwards. The suspect fell out of the car. PSD "Sando" released the bite from the leg and bit the suspect on the left wrist. I and other cover Officers approached the suspect. I took hold of PSD "Sando" and the suspects left arm and pulled him away from the car and the gun that was lying on the ground next to him. I pulled him a couple feet to the east. Ofc. Barnhill took a hold of the suspect's right arm to handcuff him. I removed PSD "Sando" from the bite. As I was removing him from the bite, PSD "Sando" bit the suspect in the back of the head. PSD "Sando" was removed from the bite and the suspect was handcuffed.

I stayed on scene to assist in maintaining the crime scene. I was relieved by Sgt Cash at approximately 0225 hours on 11-23-13.
